Main Body

Expand on the ideas presented in the introduction:

- Analyze the experience and establish connections.
- Add supporting evidence from books and articles.
- Organize your paragraphs in a logical order.

step 3

Conclusion

Summarize the essential points of the reflection:

- Say whether your expectations were met.
- Come up with an action plan.
- Describe how you're going to use your acquired knowledge and skills.
