What Is God? Thomas B. Musschenga, 1995 In the dominant view morality is more rational and universal than and therefore independent from christian religion Believers do not have exclusive moral knowledge Moral principles can be known by anyone Morality not religion is the supreme judge of human actions in the world Some contributors to this volume defend this view on theological and philosophical grounds The advantages of such a view for thinking about a common global morality are clear However according to many authors the conception of morality underlying this view is at the least impoverished if not wrong this view cannot explain the importance and the persistence of moral taboos Furthermore every morality is influenced by metaphysical and anthropological assumptions whether or not religious the so called modern rational secular morality The central moral question in the alternative narrative concept of morality is Who am I who do I want to be and not What is the right action In this approach not universal principles but tradition dependant stories constitute the core of a morality Are these concepts more adequate for understanding the relation of religion to morality Do they have room for the project of a universal morality of human rights
