A recount tells about events that have happened to you or other people. Recounts can be fiction or non-fiction.

Each part or event is in a separate paragraph.

Setting	The starting point of the story. It tells where, when the action takes place and what the writer's feelings are.
Complication (Beginning event or problem)	The event that starts the action and introduces the characters in some position. The events that develop the action and introduce the characters in some position.
Resolution	Tells how the problem is solved.
Ending	Tells what has come from the action.

Explanation

Explanation texts tell how something works. They are used in all the arts and sciences. Explanations have five parts to their frameworks.
