people in Western societies Egalitarianism as it is widely known holds that a government ought to treat all citizens with equal consideration Kekes charges that belief in egalitarianism rests on illusions that prevent people from facing unpleasant truths Kekes a major voice in modern political thought argues that differences among human beings in the areas of morality reasonability legality and citizenship are too important for governance to ignore In a rigorous criticism of prominent egalitarian thinkers including Dworkin Nagel Nussbaum Rawls Raz and Singer Kekes charges that their views present a serious threat to both morality and reason For Kekes certain inequalities are obvious people should get what they deserve those who are good and those who are evil should not be treated as if they had the same moral worth people should not be denied what they have earned in order to benefit those who have not earned it and individuals should be held responsible for their actions His provocative book will compel many readers to question their faith in liberalism
