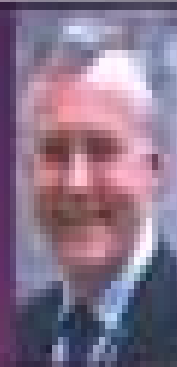


Wanless Report (2008)



- ▶ In March 2001 the Chancellor commissioned Derek Wanless to examine future health trends and to identify the key factors which will determine the financial and other resources required to ensure that the NHS can provide a publicly funded, comprehensive, high quality service available on the basis of clinical need and not ability to pay' (Department Of Health, 2008).
- ▶ Because of his assessment of the National Health Service, according to The NHS Confederation (2008) the 2002 budget included major increases in NHS spending until the year 2008 from £57.1 billion to £90.7 billion in England alone. He was able to do this through examining the demand and cost pressures in the NHS over the next two decades and recommended the amount of spending needed for it to thrive.
- ▶ His review, *Securing Good Health for the Whole Population* 'focused particularly on prevention and the wider determinants of health in England and on the cost-effectiveness of action that can be taken to improve the health of the whole population and to reduce health inequalities' (Wanless, 2004).
