

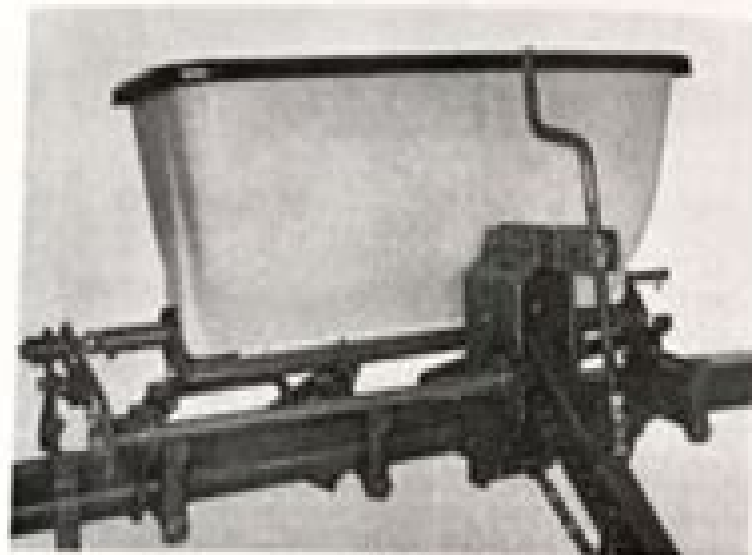

KEY FEATURES

The dry fertilizer hoppers, which are made of Douglas, permits consideration of moisture during heavy weather.

The size of hoppers are rated, a 100 pound hopper for 15 row (15-24 inch spacing) and a 400 pound hopper for 20-40 inch row spacing.

The hoppers should be cleaned and flushed thoroughly at the end of planting season. It may be necessary to clean the hoppers during planting season if fertilizer builds up in the hoppers.

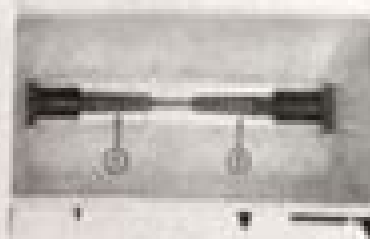

If the fertilizer adjustment parts are not used for a length of time or when making the first season, give or replace all metal parts.

To remove fertilizer from the hoppers, use a screwdriver, steel and remove the hoppers through some soil. (Figure 51) If the hoppers become caked with fertilizer, remove with a screwdriver and clean thoroughly.

CAUTION

DO NOT USE THE HOPPER CLEANING SCREWDRIVER AND CLEAN PARTS ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA.

The application rate for the 400-pound hopper can be changed by different granular conditioner and/or auger index setting. Select the application rate from the chart on page 10.

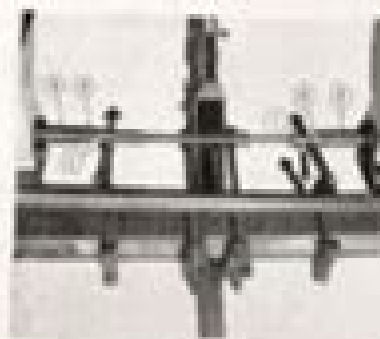

The screws on the augers are in place in the front of the hoppers. And the right-hand augers are placed in the right-hand side of the hoppers. Left-hand is the left-hand side. (Figure 52)

Adjust all the augers to the same index mark for equal fertilizer distribution. (Figure 53) To change the auger index from the just set and screw augers is in set to the index selected. Each auger is each hopper must be changed for equal fertilizer distribution in each row. These figures are set to both augers in place.

The application rate is also changed by the granular conditioner on the auger wheel drive. Granular can be changed on the auger wheel drive left and the conditioner. Select the granular conditioner from the chart on page 10 for the row index.

Tennessee Delta Quiltmaking Teri Klassen,2024-01-12 Tennessee Delta Quiltmaking is an excellent study of quilting in rural West Tennessee Both black and white quilters inhabit the small farm region and their quilting traditions are largely shared across racial lines A study that highlights shared culture rather than seeking to distinguish racial or ethnic contributions is a welcome direction in cultural research Alan Jabbour former director of the American Folklore Society Library of Congress Prior to the 1960s quiltmaking thrived in the Tennessee Delta as a crucial source of warm bedcovers among cash poor yet self sufficient farm households As agriculture mechanized rural workers switched to factory jobs and could afford nicer houses and blankets Quiltmaking survived because women both black and white reinvented it as a hobby that met personal and social needs Though scholars have studied quilt styles with rural southern roots few have considered black and white quiltmakers together or as part of a shared regional culture In Tennessee Delta Quiltmaking Teri Klassen traces how mid twentieth century common quilts developed from nineteenth century styles Through interviews with people from rural households Klassen uncovers the ways in which designs and labor were shared and the ways in which quiltmaking was part of the small farm culture that was common to blacks and whites While quiltmaking was a creative form passed down in families limited means and accessible materials made it both a necessity and a highly evolved custom in southwestern Tennessee s upper Delta region For families in this region the quilt symbolized homemaker competence and self reliance a trait especially valued by sharecroppers and tenant farmers who owned no land The culture of quiltmaking reflected living conditions and values of these folk and Klassen details numerous changes in this culture from how it contributed to small farm stability to how industrialization affected the practice By considering quiltmaking s practical aesthetic and social aspects in a historical mixed race context Tennessee Delta Quiltmaking makes a unique contribution to the study of the Tennessee Delta and the understanding of common quilt design TERI KLASSEN is a postdoctoral research associate at the Mathers Museum of World Cultures at Indiana University Her articles have appeared in Journal of American Folklore Midwestern Folklore and Journalism Quarterly

preponderance of evidence a mistake that harms us Fake history is like the Zombies we see in mass media for the fake fact like the fictional Zombie lives by turning real events and people into monstrous perversions of fact and interpretation Its pervasiveness reveals that prejudice remains its chief appeal to those who believe it Its effect is insidious because we cannot or will not destroy those mischievous lies Zombie history is almost impossible to kill Some Zombie history was and is political a genre of what Hannah Arendt called organizational lying about the past Its makers designed the Zombie to create a basis in the false past for particular discriminatory policies Other history Zombies are cultural They encapsulate and empower prejudice and stereotyping Still other popular history Zombies do not look disfigured but like Zombies walk among us without our realizing how devastating their impact can be Zombie History argues that whatever their purpose whatever the venue in which they appear history Zombies undermine the very foundations of disinterested study of the past Forward Without Fear Derek Taira,2024-06 During Hawai i s territorial period 1900 1959 Native Hawaiians resisted assimilation by refusing to replace Native culture identity and history with those of the United States By actively participating in U S public schools Hawaiians resisted the suppression of their language and culture subjection to a foreign curriculum and denial of their cultural heritage and history which was critical for Hawai i s political evolution within the manifest destiny of the United States In Forward without Fear Derek Taira reveals that many Native Hawaiians in the first forty years of the territorial period neither subscribed nor succumbed to public schools aggressive efforts to assimilate and Americanize them but instead engaged with American education to envision and support an alternate future one in which they could exclude themselves from settler society to maintain their cultural distinctiveness and protect their Indigenous identity Taira thus places great emphasis on how they would have understood their actions as flexible and productive steps for securing their cultural sovereignty and safeguarding their future as Native Hawaiians and reshapes historical understanding of this era as one solely focused on settler colonial domination oppression and elimination to a more balanced and optimistic narrative that identifies and highlights Indigenous endurance resistance and hopefulness **The Publishers' Circular and General Record of British and Foreign Literature** ,1889 **Circular** United States. Winter,2011 As a young man John B Prentis 1788 1848 expressed outrage over slavery but by the end of his life he had transported thousands of enslaved persons from the upper to the lower South Kari J Winter s life and times portrayal of a slave trader illuminates the clash between two American dreams one of wealth the other of equality Prentis was born into a prominent Virginia family His grandfather William Prentis emigrated from London to Williamsburg in 1715 as an indentured servant and rose to become the major shareholder in colonial Virginia s most successful store William s son Joseph became a Revolutionary judge and legislator who served alongside Thomas Jefferson Patrick Henry and James Madison Joseph Jr followed his father s legal career whereas John was drawn to commerce To finance his early business ventures he began trading in slaves In time he

grew besotted with the high stakes trade appeasing his conscience with the populist platitudes of Jacksonian democracy which aggressively promoted white male democracy in conjunction with white male supremacy Prentiss's life illuminates the intertwined politics of labor race class and gender in the young American nation Participating in a revolution in the ethics of labor that upheld Benjamin Franklin as its icon he rejected the gentility of his upbringing to embrace solidarity with mechanics white working class men His capacity for admirable thoughts and actions complicates images drawn by elite slaveholders who projected the worst aspects of slavery onto traders while imagining themselves as benign patriarchs This is an absorbing story of a man who betrayed his innate sense of justice to pursue wealth through the most vicious forms of human exploitation
