**Soln:**-
$$V_1 = 300$$
 c.c.  $= 0.3$  L,  $V_2 = 2.5$  L,  $T = 300$  K,  $P_{ex} = 1.9$  atm  $W = -P_{ex}\Delta V = -P_{ex}(V_2 - V_1)$   $= -1.9(2.5 - 0.3) = -1.9 \times 2.2$   $\therefore W = -4.18$  L atm and  $W = -4.18 \times 101.3 = -423.4$  J

Q2) One mole of an ideal gas is compressed from  $500~\rm cm^3$  against a constant pressure of  $1.216\times 10^5~\rm Pa$ . The work involved in the process is  $36.50~\rm J$ . Calculate the final volume.

$$V_1 = 500 \text{ c.c.} = 0.5 \text{ dm}^3$$
