sense about them all Time of course is an elementary dimension we use to organize our experiences Thus the perception of sequences is basic to human cognition Nevertheless research addressing sequences is rather sparse Partly this is due to difficulty in designing experiments in this area due to huge individual differences Then there is the assumption that temporal order has more to do with memory than perception Another problem is that sequences seem endemic to the auditory world So much so that some researchers have suggested that sound provides the auditory scaffolding for sequencing behavior Little wonder that research studies addressing sequences in modalities other than audition are extremely rare This research topic aimed to gather a holistic picture of sequencing behaviour among humans by collecting snapshots of the current research on the topic of sequencing We particularly sought contributions which addressed sequences beyond the auditory modality The single unifying criteria for these diverse contributions was that they shed new light on previously unexplored empirical relationships and or provoked new lines of research with incisive ideas regarding sequencing behavior Seasoned researchers contributed their views on perception memory and production of sequences
