South Africa's Post-Apartheid Military Lindy Heineken, 2020-01-01 This timely book examines how the South African National Defence Force has adapted to the country's new security political and social environment since 1994. In South Africa's changed political state, how has civilian control of the military been implemented and what does this mean for defence in a democracy? This book presents an overview of the security environment, how the mission focus of the military has changed and the implications for force procurement, force preparation, force employment and force sustainability. The author addresses other issues such as the effect of integrating former revolutionary soldiers into a professional armed force, the effect of affirmative action on meritocracy, recruitment and retention, military veterans looking at the difficulties they face in reintegrating back into society and finding gainful employment, gender equality and mainstreaming, the rise of military unions and why a confrontational instead of a more corporatist approach to labour relations has emerged, HIV/AIDS and the consequences this holds for the military in terms of its operational effectiveness. In closing, the author highlights key events that have caused the SANDF to become lost in transition and transformation, spelling out some lessons learned. The conclusions she draws are pertinent for the future of defence security and civil-military relations of countries around the world.

Infrastructures of Migrant Labour in Colonial Ovamboland, 1915 to 1954 Lovisa Nampala, 2023-09-23 Most research on the migrant labour system in Namibia under South African colonial rule emphasises its dehumanising aspects. In a complete contrast, this study highlights the social and ritual resources that contract workers and their families in colonial Ovamboland mobilised to provide forms of support and connection across great distances and absences. Based on extensive oral research, this study peels back the layers of intangible infrastructure that sustained migrant workers through all the stages of their contract, including observances around workplace deaths. This thesis vividly demonstrates the persistence of older practices that sustained the bonds of life fellowship and family under stress as well as adaptation to new colonial system such as the postal system.

Private Military and Security Contractors Gary Schaub, Jr., Ryan Kelty, 2016-06-16 In *Private Military and Security Contractors*, PMSCs, a multinational team of scholars and experts address a developing phenomenon: controlling the use of privatized force by states in international politics. Robust analyses of the evolving multi-layered tapestry of formal and informal mechanisms of control address the microfoundations of the market, such as the social and role identities of contract employees, their acceptance by military personnel and potential tensions between them. The extent and willingness of key states—South Africa, the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom and Israel—to monitor and enforce discipline to structure their contractual relations with PMSCs on land and at sea is examined, as is the ability of the industry to regulate itself. Also discussed is the nascent international legal regime to reinforce state and industry efforts to encourage effective practices, punish inappropriate behavior and shape the market to minimize the hazards of loosening states' oligopolistic control over the means of legitimate organized violence. authoritarian regimes Mass killing and genocide defy reason and explanation How can genocidal elites present defenceless victims as an existential threat Why use indiscriminate killing that drives victims to coordinated resistance Mass killing seems counterproductive irrational and therefore inherently ideological By building on new insights on authoritarian politics this book argues that mass killing is not ideological but instead is a rational response to elite rivalry within authoritarian regimes Mass killing is therefore not driven by rivalries between groups but by elite rivalry within groups In Rwanda for example the genocide was not driven by conflicts between Hutu and Tutsi but by conflicts within the Hutu regime The work demonstrates how mass killing helps elites build coalitions with groups that benefit from violence and how it divides support coalitions of rival elites Mass killing can therefore help elites win dangerous internal rivalries By qualitatively and quantitatively exploring elite rivalry and mass killing this book provides a new explanation for a host of mass killings and genocides It demonstrates that well known genocides such as the Rwandan and Cambodian genocides which are seemingly ideological are instead better explained by elite rivalry Mass killing is therefore not driven by the random madness of leaders nor by the desire to kill an outgroup but by the internal threats that authoritarian elites face This book will be of much interest to scholars and students of civil wars genocide political violence and International Relations in general
