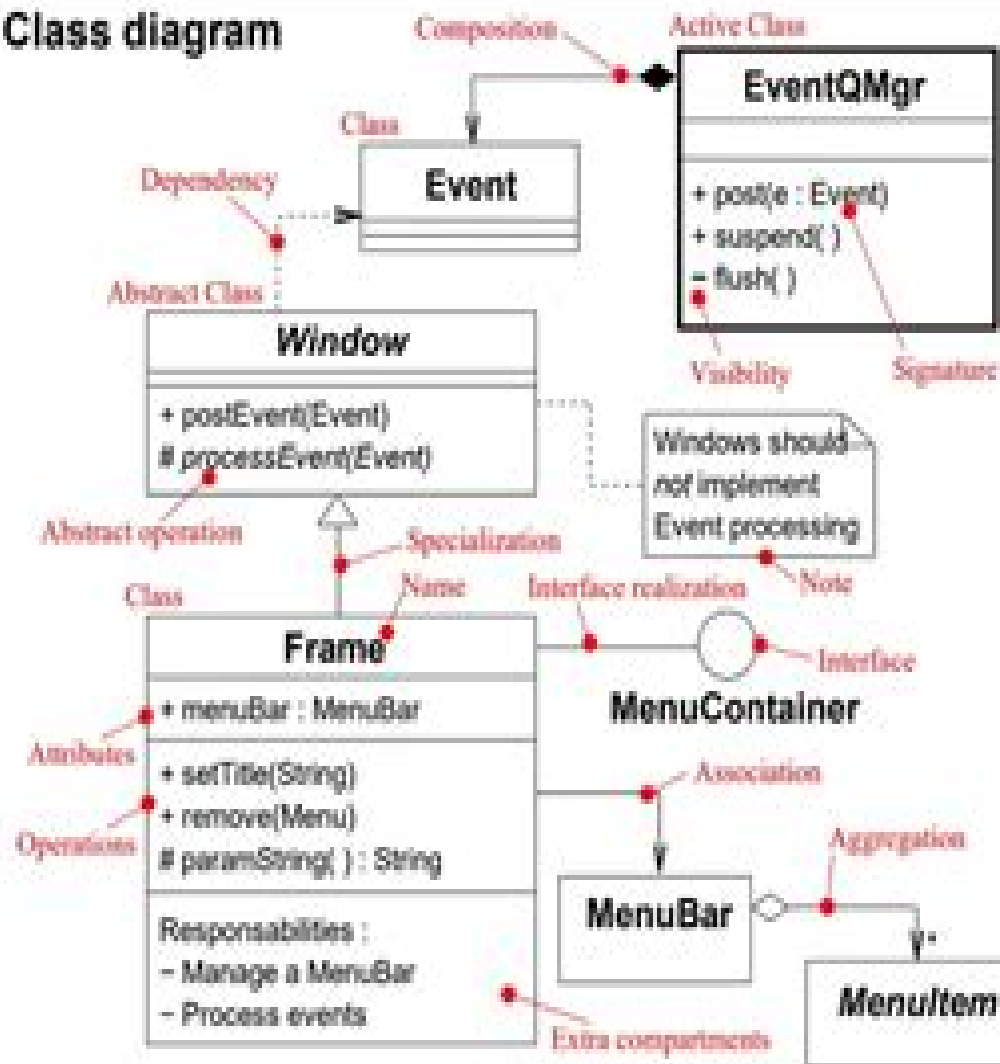
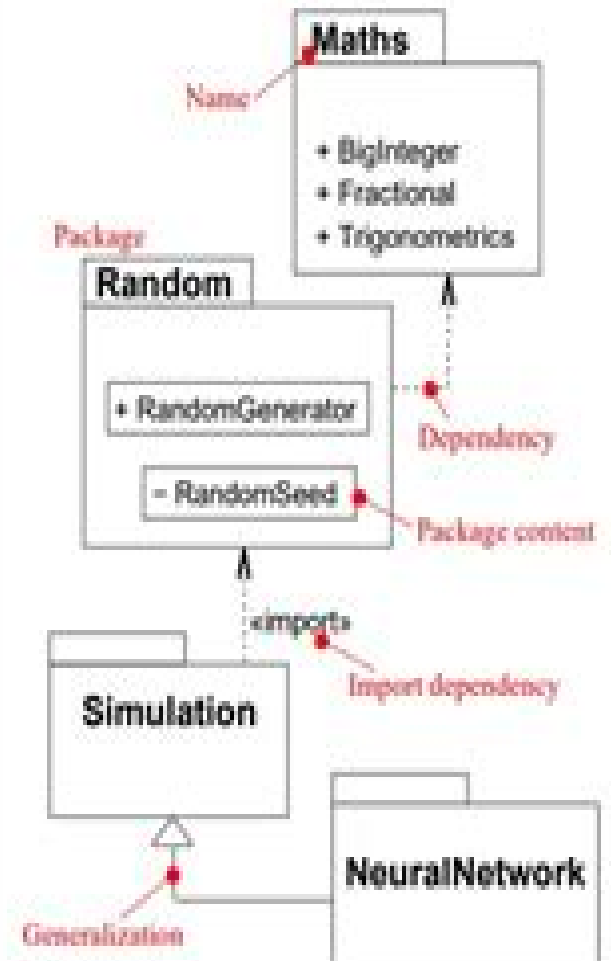


Class diagram
