#### Question 1

You have been asked to estimate the weighted average cost of capital (WACC) for Germina Corp., a mid-cap Pharmaceutical company in New York. You have been provided with the following information.

- 1. Common Shares the current market price of Germina's 100,000 common shares on the NYSE stock exchange is \$3 per share. Germina just paid a dividend of \$0.75 per share last year and the company's financial analysts have indicated that the dividends should grow at an average annual rate of 2% for the foreseeable future.
- 2. Preferred Shares The Company also has 200,000 preferred shares that carry a stated dividend of \$1.00 per share and have a current market price of \$5 per share.
- 3. Germina has 1,500 \$1,000 face value bonds outstanding that carry a 10% coupon rate. The Yield to Maturity is 8%. The bonds will mature in 20 years. Bond interest is paid semi-annually.

Germina Corp's tax rate is 40%.
