

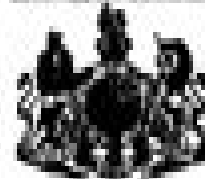

The Origins and Impact of the Northcote-Trevelyan Report on Civil Service Reform in Britain Mary Clarke, 2010 **The Official History of the British Civil Service** Rodney Lowe, 2011-01-25 This first volume of the Official History of the UK Civil Service covers its evolution from the Northcote Trevelyan Report of 1854 to the first years of Mrs Thatcher's government in 1981. Despite current concerns with good governance and policy delivery little serious attention has been paid to the institution vital to both the Civil Service. This Official History is designed to remedy this by placing present problems in historical context and by providing a helpful structure in which others and particularly former officials may contribute to the debate. Starting with the seminal 1854 Northcote Trevelyan Report it covers the lost opportunity of the 1940s when the Service failed to adapt the needs of big government as advocated by Beveridge and Keynes. It then examines in greater detail the belated attempts at modernisation in the 1960s, the Service's vilification in the 1970s and the final destruction of the old order during the first years of Mrs Thatcher's government. Particular light is shed on the origins of such current concerns as the role of special advisers, the need for a Prime Minister's Department, the evolution of Parliamentary Select Committees to resolve the potential tension between bureaucracy and Parliamentary democracy. This Official History is based on extensive research into both recently released and unreleased papers as well as interviews with leading participants. It has important lessons to offer all those both inside and outside the UK seeking to improve the quality of democratic government. Secular Foundations of the Liberal State in Victorian Britain William C. Lubenow, 2024 Examines the entanglement of secularity and liberality in the foundation of the modern state in Britain Modern Britain emerged from the outcome of the French Revolution and the Napoleonic Wars The rather standard Whig account of the long nineteenth century is one of growing stability progress and improvement And yet nothing was preordained or inevitable about the period's stability Ruling elites felt the constant anxieties of revolutionary terrorism As Lubenow argues it was a period of disorganization seeking organization The great nineteenth century reform acts against religious monopoly were aspects of this process of political organization While religion did not disappear these political actions gradually changed the constitutional position of religion As a result a political vacuum was created which was then filled by a secular clerisy These fit and proper persons educated in the reformed universities qualified by success in competitive examinations began to fill positions in the Civil Service and in the professions The effect was to replace the eighteenth century system of confessional loyalties with a liberal political culture based on merit Lubenow's latest study examines the work of these intertwining nineteenth century secular liberal processes Steeped deeply in archival research this book considers biographical characteristics such as education political connections and social associations but it is equally conceptually guided by categories such as liberalism and secularism It fills an important gap in the political history of nineteenth century British liberalism by taking up the question of entanglement of secularity and liberality in the foundation of the modern state

The Rise of Political Advisors in the Westminster System Yee-Fui Ng, 2018-04-17 Political advisors have risen in significance in Westminster countries and have been increasingly thrust into the limelight by headline scandals and through their characterisation in various television series This increased prominence has led to greater scrutiny of their role and influence This book demonstrates that the introduction of political advisors into the structure of the executive has led to the erosion of the Westminster doctrine of ministerial responsibility Adopting a comparative approach the book analyses the rise in the power and significance of political advisors in the Westminster jurisdictions of the United Kingdom Australia New Zealand and Canada It shows the fundamental shift of the locus of power from the neutral public service to highly political and partisan ministerial advisors Tracing the divergent paths for legal and political regulation of political advisors Yee Fui Ng illuminates the tensions that they pose within the Westminster system in terms of the media politics and faction opposition interfaces Providing insights for those researching or engaged in politics and public administration this work will interest scholars and students of politics and public law policy and administration
