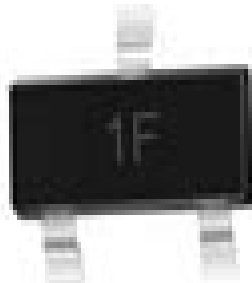

Specifically it treats hyperspectral image processing and hyperspectral signal processing as separate subjects in two different categories. Most materials covered in this book can be used in conjunction with the author's first book *Hyperspectral Imaging Techniques for Spectral Detection and Classification* without much overlap. Many results in this book are either new or have not been explored, presented or published in the public domain.
