STUDENT's articulation skills were formally assessed using the GELA₂. Assessment targets in the initial, medial and final positions of the word were elicited in single-word utterances and in sentences. To collect data in single-word utterances, **STUDENT** was presented with 48 colored pictures and was asked to name them spontaneously. During this task, **STUDENT** exhibited **X** speech errors and obtained a standard score of **X**. To collect data at the sentence level, **STUDENT** participated in sentence repetition tasks. During sentence repetition tasks **STUDENT** exhibited **X** speech errors and obtained a standard score of **X**.

Below is a table representative of the single word errors **STUDENT** exhibited during administration of the Sounds in Words subtest. The table also indicates the state's designated age at sound acquisition.

STUDENT's single word errors consisted of **substitutions/omissions/distortions/additions**. **STUDENT's** single word errors were compared to the state of Missouri's normative data for sound acquisition. The state of Missouri's normative data for sound acquisition suggests that the **X** phonemes are typically acquired by **X** years of age. **STUDENT's** word production of these phonemes **was not** considered developmentally appropriate at **STUDENT's** chronological age level of **X** years, **X** months. The evaluating speech-language pathologist determined that **STUDENT's** errors are not the result of dialectal differences or second language influence.

MISSOURI STATE PROGRAM ON EARLY CHILD LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT (ELPA-2)

The ELPA-2 is a norm-referenced analysis of an individual's speech development and phonological process usage. It is designed for use with individuals between the ages of two and 21 years. The analysis is used to identify frequency of usage of twelve Core Phonological Processes grouped into four types (insertions, place, reduction, and voicing) and thirteen Supplemental and other processes used by the individual. The ELPA-2 requires the administration of the Sounds in Words subtest of the Goldsmith-Friesen Test of Articulation – Third Edition (GFTA-3). The target words of the (GFTA-3) are analyzed for sound changes and the sound changes are classified by phonological process(es). The total number of phonological
