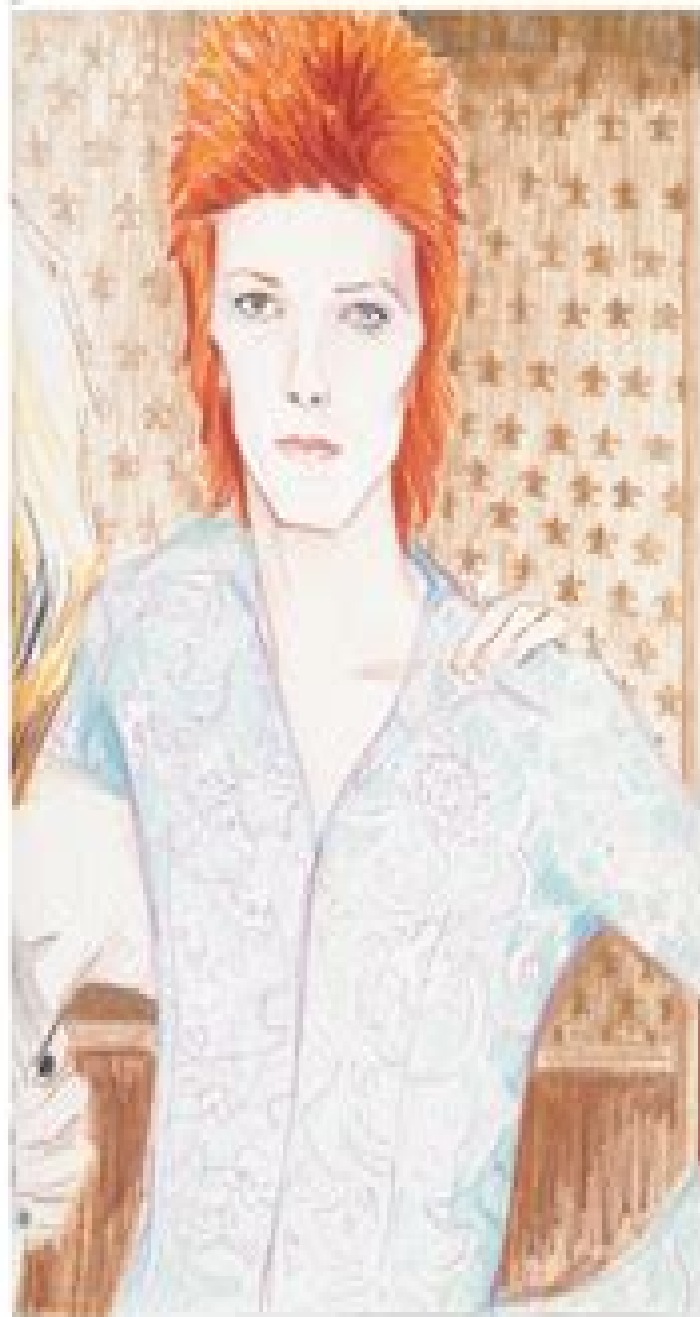

Drawing Difference argues that these developments did not occur in parallel simply by coincidence.
