Vivre De Sa Plume:

The Literary Market Geoffrey Turnovsky, 2011-07-07 A central theme in the history of Old Regime authorship highlights the opportunities offered by a growing book trade to writers seeking to free themselves from patrons and live by the pen. Accounts of this passage from patronage to market have explored in far greater detail the opportunities themselves, the rising sums paid by publishers and the progression of laws protecting literary property than how and why writers would have seized on them, no doubt because the choice to do so has seemed an obvious or natural one for writers assumed to prefer economic self-sufficiency over elite protection. In *The Literary Market*, Geoffrey Turnovsky claims that there was nothing obvious or natural about the choice. Writers had been involved in commercial book publication since the earliest days of the printing press yet had not necessarily linked these activities with their freedom to think and write. The association of autonomy and professionalism was forged not given. Analyzing the literary market as a key articulation of the association, Turnovsky explores how in eighteenth-century polemics a rhetoric of commercial authorship came to signify independence for intellectuals. He finds the roots of the connection not in the claims of entrepreneurial writers to rights and income but in a world to which that of the modern author has been contrasted: the aristocratic culture of the seventeenth century. Aristocratic culture, he argues, generated a disparaging view of the professional author as one defined by activities tainting him or her as greedy and arrogant and therefore unworthy of protection and socially isolated. *The Literary Market* examines the story of the birth of the author in terms of the revalorization of this negative trope in Enlightenment-era debates about the radically changing role of writers in society.

Oeuvres complètes de H. de Balzac Honoré : de Balzac, 1855 **The Shakespearean comic and tragicomic** Richard Hillman, 2020-01-20 In exploring links between the early modern English theatre and France, Richard Hillman focuses on Shakespeare's deployment of genres whose dominant Italian models and affinities might seem to leave little scope for French ones. The author draws on specific and unsuspected points of contact whilst also pointing out a broad tendency by the dramatist to draw on French material both dramatic and non-dramatic to inflect comic forms in potentially tragic directions. The resulting internal tensions are evident from the earliest comedies to the latest tragicomedies or romances. While its many original readings will interest specialists and students of Shakespeare, this book will have broader appeal: it contributes significantly from an unfamiliar angle to the contemporary discourse concerned with early modern English culture within the European context. At the same time, it is accessible to a wide range of readers, with translations provided for all non-English citations.

Shakespeare's French Connection Margrethe Jolly, 2024-07-18 Shakespeare most often locates his plays in Italy and England, and his third most frequent setting is France. Indeed, nearly 70 scenes, at a conservative count, and perhaps as many as 100, take place in France in a variety of significant geographical locations. French is also the foreign language Shakespeare uses most; he is sufficiently au fait with French to use it for puns and scatological jokes. He weaves in comments on French fashion, ways of walking, and skills in horsemanship.

sword playing and dancing Not only does Shakespeare draw directly or indirectly upon French chroniclers but he also presents us with parts of French history Many French characters people his stage sometimes historical figures appear as themselves and sometimes they are alluded to And the plays demonstrate Shakespeare's reading in French literature and how that influenced him This work shows us just how widely that French presence is evident in his plays Other books and articles may focus on Shakespeare's familiarity with Italy the bible law medicine or astronomy for example This book adds to those shining another spotlight on Shakespeare's remarkable knowledge and eclectic reading confirming him yet again as a truly extraordinary Renaissance figure

Urban Poetics in the French Renaissance Elisabeth Hodges, 2016-12-05 The city view forms the jumping off point for this innovative study which explores how the concept of the city relates to the idea of the self in early modern French narratives At a time when print culture cartography and literature emerged and developed together the city view a picture or topographic image of a city became one of the most distinctive and popular products of the early modern period Through a construct she calls urban poetics Elisabeth Hodges draws out the relationship between the city and the self showing the impact of the city in cultural production to be so profound that it cannot be extricated from what we know by the name of subjectivity Each chapter of the book brings focus to a crucial text that features descriptions of the self in the city by the writers Villon Corrozet Scève and Montaigne and investigate how representations of urban experience prepared the way for the emergence of the autonomous subject Charting a course between cartography literary studies and cultural history this study opens new vistas on some of the period's defining problems the book the subject the city

Music, Authorship, and the Book in the First Century of Print Kate van Orden, 2013-10-19 What does it mean to author a piece of music What transforms the performance scripts written down by musicians into authored books In this fascinating cultural history of Western music's adaptation to print Kate van Orden looks at how musical authorship first developed through the medium of printing When music printing began in the sixteenth century publication did not always involve the composer printers used the names of famous composers to market books that might include little or none of their music Publishing sacred music could be career building for a composer while some types of popular song proved too light to support a reputation in print no matter how quickly they sold Van Orden addresses the complexities that arose for music and musicians in the burgeoning cultures of print concluding that authoring books of polyphony gained only uneven cultural traction across a century in which composers were still first and foremost performers

Dogs' Tales Hugh Roberts, 2006-01-01 Sleeping rough having sex in public and insulting the most powerful men in the world earned the ancient Cynic or dog philosophers fame and infamy in antiquity and beyond This book reveals that French Renaissance texts feature a rich and varied set of responses to the Dogs including especially Diogenes of Sinope 4th century B C whose life was a subversive performance combining wisdom and wisecracks Cynicism is a special case in the renewal of interest in ancient philosophy at this time owing to its transmission through jokes and anecdotes The Cynics curious combination of seduction and sedition goes a long way to account for both the excitement and the tension that they generate in Renaissance texts Responses to the extreme and deliberately marginal philosophical stance of the Dogs cast light back on the mainstream revealing cultural attitudes tensions and uncertainties Above all representations of Cynicism constitute a site for the exploration of strange and paradoxical ideas in playful and humorous ways This is true of both major writers including Erasmus Rabelais and Montaigne and of dozens of other less well known but fascinating figures This book will be of interest to students and scholars of intellectual and literary history

Bicultural Literature and Film in French and English Peter I. Barta, Phil Powrie, 2015-12-22 This book focuses on literature and cinema in English or French by authors and directors not working in their native language Artists with hybrid identities have become a defining phenomenon of contemporary reality following the increased mobility between civilisations during the postcolonial period and the waves of emigration to the West Cinema and prose fiction remain the most popular sources of cultural consumption not least owing to the adaptability of both to the new electronic media This volume considers cultural products in English and French in which the explicitly multi focal representation of authors experiences of their native languages cultures makes itself conspicuous The essays explore work by the peripheral and those without a country while problematising what might be meant by the widely used but not always well defined term bicultural The first section looks at films by such well known filmmakers working in France as Bouchareb Kechiche Legzouli and Dridi as well as the animated feature Persepolis Here the focus is on the representation of human experience in spatial terms exploring the appropriation of territory cohabited by local people newcomers and their children haunted by the cultural memories of distant places The second part is devoted to multicultural authors whose native language was English Russian Polish Hungarian or Spanish Beckett Herzen Voeikova Triolet Conrad Hoffmann Kristof Dorfman and their creative engagement with difference A study of the emergence of multilingual writing in Montaigne and an autobiographical essay by Elleke Boehmer on growing up

surrounded by English Dutch Afrikaans and Zulu frame the volume's chapters The collection relishes the freedom provided by liberation from the confines of one language and culture and the delight in creative multilingualism This book will be of significant interest to those studying the subject of biculturalism as well as the fields of comparative literature and cinema

French Reflections in the Shakespearean Tragic Richard Hillman, 2018-07-30 Hillman explores English tragedy in relation to France with a frank concentration on Shakespeare He sets out to theorise more abstract tragic qualities such as nostalgia futility and heroism with reference to specific French texts and contexts Three manifestations of the Shakespearean tragic are singled out Hamlet Antony and Cleopatra and All's Well That Ends Well a comedy with melancholic overtones whose French setting is shown to be richly significant Hillman brings to bear on each of these central works a cluster of French intertextual echoes sometimes literary in origin whether dramatic or otherwise sometimes involving historical texts memoirs or contemporary political documents which have no obvious connection with the plays but prove capable of enriching interpretation of them It will be of interest not only to scholars specialising in early modern English theatre but also to both specialists and students concerned with the circulation of information and the production of meaning within early modern European culture
