- Performance is measured in time (in seconds), using a stop watch, and the total number of errors, determined by the number of times the participant enters a dead end or fails to stay in the lines
- If the maze has not been completed in 3 minutes, discontinue
- Cutoffs:
  - 61 seconds or longer = fail
  - 60 seconds or less with 2 or more errors = fail
  - 60 seconds or less with 0 or 1 error = passes


