South Africa's Post-Apartheid Military Lindy Heineken, 2020-01-01 This timely book examines how the South African National Defence Force has adapted to the country's new security political and social environment since 1994. In South Africa's changed political state, how has civilian control of the military been implemented and what does this mean for defence in a democracy? This book presents an overview of the security environment, how the mission focus of the military has changed and the implications for force procurement, force preparation, force employment and force sustainability. The author addresses other issues such as the effect of integrating former revolutionary soldiers into a professional armed force, the effect of affirmative action on meritocracy, recruitment and retention of military veterans, looking at the difficulties they face in reintegrating back into society and finding gainful employment, gender equality and mainstreaming the rise of military unions and why a confrontational instead of a more corporatist approach to labour relations has emerged. HIV/AIDS and the consequences this holds for the military in terms of its operational effectiveness. In closing, the author highlights key events that have caused the SANDF to become lost in transition and transformation, spelling out some lessons learned. The conclusions she draws are pertinent for the future of defence security and civil-military relations of countries around the world.

Politics the politics of the Global South and Chinese Studies *Towards an International Code of Conduct for Private Security Providers* Anne-Marie Buzatu, 2015-09-19 The use of private security companies PSCs to provide security services has been on the rise since the end of the Cold War with PSCs operating in a number of contexts including armed conflict and areas where the rule of law has been compromised The use of private actors to perform services that are traditionally associated with the state is not limited to PSCs but is emblematic of a growing trend by governments to outsource functions with a view to improving efficiency and cutting budgets Privatization of public functions can however present a number of challenges to existing national and international regulatory and oversight frameworks In the private security sector these challenges were brought to international attention after high profile incidents in which PSCs injured civilians revealed difficulties in effectively holding international PSCs accountable This paper argues that crafting a multistakeholder regulatory approach in which key stakeholders work together to develop standards that are appropriately adapted for the private sector as well as to create governance and oversight mechanisms to hold these private actors to effective account helps to fill some of the governance gaps found in traditional regulatory approaches It recounts the developments leading to the International Code of Conduct for Private Security Service Providers ICOC and its governance and oversight mechanism the ICOC Association offering an example of the development of an initiative which sets new international standards and elaborates a multistakeholder framework and approach to governance for the private security sector A recent trend of state and non state clients requiring compliance with the ICOC initiative in their contracts with PSCs offers a new take on binding international regulation of private actors **Black Colleges Across the Diaspora** M.
