Stilicho Ian Hughes, 2010-06-19 A military history of the campaigns of Stilicho the army general who became one of the most powerful men in the Western Roman Empire Flavius Stilicho lived in one of the most turbulent periods in European history The Western Empire was finally giving way under pressure from external threats especially from Germanic tribes crossing the Rhine and Danube as well as from seemingly ever present internal revolts and rebellions Ian Hughes explains how a Vandal actually Stilicho had a Vandal father and Roman mother came to be given almost total control of the Western Empire and describes his attempts to save both the Western Empire and Rome itself from the attacks of Alaric the Goth and other barbarian invaders Stilicho is one of the major figures in the history of the Late Roman Empire and his actions following the death of the emperor Theodosius the Great in 395 may have helped to divide the Western and Eastern halves of the Roman Empire on a permanent basis Yet he is also the individual who helped maintain the integrity of the West before the rebellion of Constantine III in Britain and the crossing of the Rhine by a major force of Vandals Sueves and Alans both in A D 406 set the scene for both his downfall and execution in 408 and the later disintegration of the West Despite his role in this fascinating and crucial period of history there is no other full length biography of him in print *Arianism: Roman Heresy and Barbarian Creed* Guido M. Berndt, 2016-04-15 This is the first volume to attempt a comprehensive overview of the evolution of the Arian churches in the Roman world of Late Antiquity and their political importance in the late Roman kingdoms of the 5th 6th centuries ruled by barbarian warrior elites Bringing together researchers from the disciplines of theology history and archaeology and providing an extensive bibliography it constitutes a breakthrough in a field largely neglected in historical studies A polemical term coined by the Orthodox Church the side that prevailed in the Trinitarian disputes of the 4th century C E for its opponents in theology as well as in ecclesiastical politics Arianism has often been seen as too complicated to understand outside the group of theological specialists dealing with it and has therefore sometimes been ignored in historical studies The studies here offer an introduction to the subject grounded in the historical context then examine the adoption of Arian Christianity among the Gothic contingents of the Roman army and its subsequent diffusion in the barbarian kingdoms of the late Roman world **The Vandals** Simon MacDowall, 2016-07-31 An up close look at the Germanic people who sacked Rome in the fifth century AD On 31 December AD 406 a group of German tribes crossed the Rhine pierced the Roman defensive lines and began a rampage across Roman Gaul sacking cities such as Metz Arras and Strasbourg Foremost amongst them were the Vandals and their search for a new homeland took them on the most remarkable odyssey The Romans were unable to stop them and their closest allies the Alans marching the breadth of Gaul crossing the Pyrenees and making themselves masters of Spain However this kingdom of the Vandals and Alans soon came under intense pressure from Rome's Visigothic allies In 429 under their new king Gaiseric they crossed the straits of Gibraltar to North Africa They quickly overran this rich Roman province and established a stable kingdom Taking to the seas

they soon dominated the Western Mediterranean and raided Italy famously sacking Rome itself in 455 Eventually however they were utterly conquered by Belisarius in 533 and vanished from history Simon MacDowall narrates and analyzes these events with particular focus on the evolution of Vandal armies and warfare *"Montanism" in the Roman World* Peter Lampe, Heidrun E.
