Braun, 2009-03-08 An understanding of the uniquely human behavior of stone tool making tackles questions about hominins ability to culturally transmit and expand their base of social and practical knowledge and their cognitive capacities for advanced planning The appearance of stone tools has often been viewed as a threshold event impacting directly and profoundly the later course of cultural and social evolution Alternatively it has been understood as a prelude to significant succeeding changes in behavioral social and biological evolution of hominins This book presents a series of recent enquiries into the technological and adaptive significance of Oldowan stone tools While anchored in a long research tradition these studies rely on recent discoveries and innovative analyses of the archaeological record of ca 2 6 1 0 million years ago in Africa and Eurasia dealing with the earliest lithic industries as manifestations of hominin adaptations and as expressions of hominin cognitive abilities **Making a Mark** Andrew Meirion Jones, Marta Díaz-Guardamino, 2019-03-31 The visual imagery of Neolithic Britain and Ireland is spectacular While the imagery of passage tombs such as Knowth and Newgrange are well known the rich imagery on decorated portable artefacts is less well understood How does the visual imagery found on decorated portable artefacts compare with other Neolithic imagery such as passage tomb art and rock art How do decorated portable artefacts relate chronologically to other examples of Neolithic imagery Using cutting edge digital imaging techniques the Making a Mark project examined Neolithic decorated portable artefacts of chalk stone bone antler and wood from three key regions southern England and East Anglia the Irish Sea region Wales the Isle of Man and eastern Ireland and Northeast Scotland and Orkney Digital analysis revealed for the first time the prevalence of practices of erasure and reworking amongst a host of decorated portable artefacts changing our understanding of these enigmatic artefacts Rather than mark making being a peripheral activity we can now appreciate the central importance of mark making to the formation of Neolithic communities across Britain and Ireland The volume visually documents and discusses the contexts of the decorated portable artefacts from each region discusses the significance and chronology of practices of erasure and reworking and compares these practices with those found in other Neolithic contexts such as passage tomb art rock art and pottery decoration A contribution from Antonia Thomas also discusses the settlement art and mortuary art of Orkney while Ian Dawson and Louisa Minkin contribute with a discussion of the collaborative fine art practices established during the project *Bronze Age Worlds* Robert Johnston, 2020-10-26 Bronze Age Worlds brings a new way of thinking about kinship to the task of explaining the formation of social life in Bronze Age Britain and Ireland Britain and Ireland s diverse landscapes and societies experienced varied and profound transformations during the twenty fifth to eighth centuries BC People s lives were shaped by migrations changing beliefs about death making and thinking with metals

The Archaeology of the Lower City and Adjacent Suburbs Jenny Mann, Alan Vince, Jane Young, 2016-04-30 This volume contains reports on excavations undertaken in the lower walled city at Lincoln which lies on sloping ground on the northern scarp of the Witham gap and its adjacent suburbs between 1972 and 1987 and forms a companion volume to LAS volumes 2 and 3 which cover other parts of the historic city The earliest features encountered were discovered both near to the line of Ermine Street and towards Broadgate Remains of timber storage buildings were found probably associated with the Roman legionary occupation in the later 1st century AD The earliest occupation of the hillside after the foundation of the colonia towards the end of the century consisted mainly of commercial premises modest residences and storage buildings It seems likely that the boundary of the lower enclosure was designated before it was fortified in the later 2nd century with the street pattern belonging to the earlier part of the century Larger aristocratic residences came to dominate the hillside with public facilities fronting on to the line of the zigzagging main route In the 4th century the fortifications were enlarged and two new gates inserted Examples of so called Dark Earth deposits were here dated to the very latest phases of Roman occupation Elements of some Roman structures survived to be reused in subsequent centuries There are hints of one focus in the Middle Saxon period in the area of St Peter's church but occupation of an urban nature did not recommence until the late 9th century with the first phases of Anglo Scandinavian occupation recorded here Sequences of increasingly intensive occupation from the 10th century were identified with plentiful evidence for industrial activity including pottery metalworking and other crafts as well as parish churches Markets were established in the 11th century and stone began to replace timber for residential structures from the mid 12th century with clear evidence of the quality of some of the houses With the decline in the city's fortunes from the late 13th century the fringe sites became depopulated and there was much rebuilding elsewhere including some fine new houses There was a further revival in the later post medieval period but much of the earlier fabric and surviving stretches of Roman city wall were swept away in the 19th century

Moving on in Neolithic Studies Jim Leary, Thomas Kador, 2016-02-29 Mobility is a fundamental facet of being human and should be central to archaeology Yet mobility itself and the role it plays in the production of social life is rarely considered as a subject in its own right This is particularly so with discussions of the Neolithic people where mobility is often framed as being somewhere between a sedentary existence and nomadic movements This latest collection of papers from the Neolithic Studies Group seminars
