- Your Name
- Your Professor's Name
- Course Name
- Date
- **Formatting:** Left-aligned, Times New Roman, 12 pt.

2. Headers

Headers appear at the top of each page and include essential information about the author and the page number.

2.1 Running Head

This is a short version of your title. It should be left-aligned and all in capital letters.

- **Formatting:** Left-aligned, Times New Roman, 12 pt, Capital letters
