

OBSERVING Sky at a Glance

AUGUST 2015

- DAWN** All month, look about 1° left of Saturn in the south-southwest sky about an hour after sunset for the telescopic double star Beta (β) Crucis, left in upper left of Beta is another fine double, the six Crucis. High power is great seeing reveals this as the Southern Double Double.
- MORNING** The Moon, just past full quarter, forms a triangle with the Pleiades and Antares in Taurus.
- DAWN** Look for the orange glow of Mars in the planet chase in the east-southeast. Find it against nearly 1° below Polaris in the sky brightens.
- DAWN** On this is the next five mornings, look low in the east-southeast about 30 minutes before sunrise for the brilliant ring (first seen visibility of Mars as it emerges from the Sun's glare).
- LATE MORNING TO DAWN** The Pleiades meteor shower peaks tonight, a morning meteor shower takes the sky during conditions this year. This is a long lasting shower, so it's worth observing on the preceding and following nights as well, see page 56.
- DAWN** Observe the Mercury about 1° right of the first upward Moon, very low in the east.
- DAWN** The first quarter Moon shows less than 1° from Saturn, just above and right of Beta Crucis.
- DAWN** Look due east about a half hour before sunrise, when Venus is near about 10° above the horizon.
