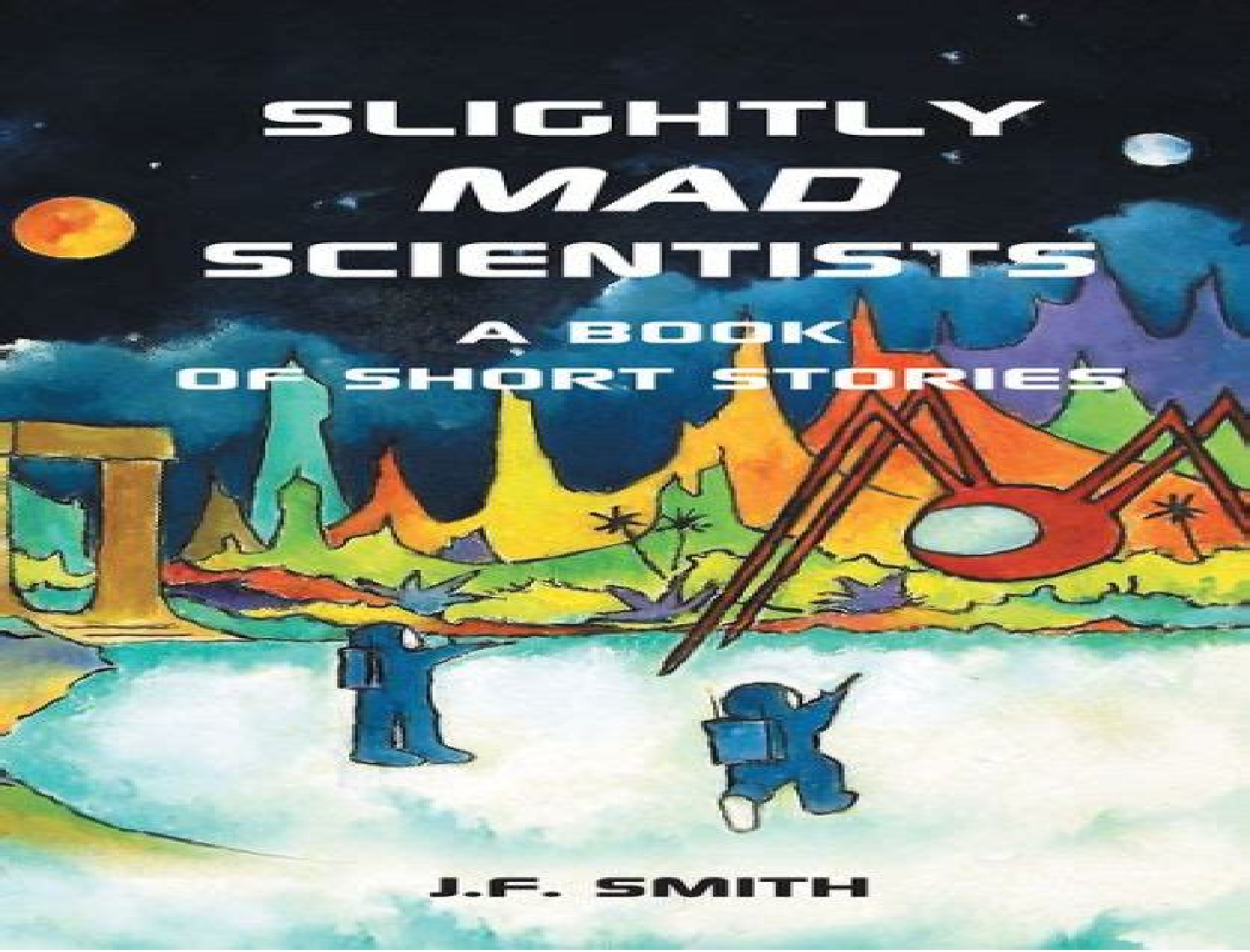

From the publication of his first book in 1905 until his death Lord Dunsany 1878 1957 was an immensely popular Anglo Irish writer He has long been admired in the realms of fantasy horror and supernatural fiction and was a friend and colleague of
