Volume 2* Christopher Shores, Giovanni Massimello, Russell Guest, Frank Olynk, Winfried Bock, 2014-07-19 This second volume in the seminal series on aerial combat pilots and tactics in Libya and Egypt in the middle of World War II In volume two of this series historian Christopher Shores begins by exploring the 8th Army's movements after Operation Crusader when they were forced back to the Gazala area in northeastern Libya as well as their defeat in June 1942 the loss of Tobruk and the efforts of Allied air forces to protect their retreating troops Shores continues with the heavy fighting that followed in the El Alamein region This features the Western Desert Air Force and the arrival of the first Spitfires The buildup of both army and air forces and the addition of new commanders on the ground aided the defeat of Rommel's Deutsche Afrika Korps at Alam el Halfa after which came the Second Battle of El Alamein With the arrival of the United States Army Air Force the Allied air forces gained dominance over the Axis Shores recounts the lengthy pursuit of the Italo German forces right across Libya including the capture of Tripoli and the breakthrough into Southern Tunisia This allowed a linkup with other Allied forces in Tunisia whose story appears in Volume 3 Included with the action are stories of some of the great fighter aces of the Desert campaign such as Jochen Marseille and Otto Schulz of the Luftwaffe Franco Bordoni Bisleri of the Regia Aeronautica and Neville Duke Billy Drake and Eddie Edwards of the Commonwealth air forces Finally Shores touches on the Allied and Axis night bombing offensives and the activities of the squadrons cooperating with the naval forces in the Mediterranean Air Pictorial ,2001-07 **Air Combat Legends: Supermarine Spitfire, Messerschmitt Bf109** ,2004

Spitfire Aces of the Channel Front 1941-43 Andrew Thomas, 2016-06-16 80 years after the Spitfire was first developed it remains an icon of military aviation Though many associate its victory during the Battle of Britain as the high point in the history of the Spitfire the years following were of equal importance Having weathered the initial storm at the start of 1941 Fighter Command took the fight to the Germans with offensive missions over the Channel This book reveals how first using the Spitfire I and II and then following the introduction of the Bf 109 the cannon armed Spitfire V RAF squadrons embarked on a range of missions which included one of the most important air battles of the war over Dieppe on

19 August 1942 Alongside British pilots were squadrons manned by exiled Europeans and pilots from the RAAF RCAF and RNZAF In just three years over 100 of these pilots were to rack up ace status in the Spitfire The British National Bibliography Arthur James Wells,1972 *The Empire Has An Answer* Tony James Brady,2019-06-05 If we do not win the battle of training we shall win no other battle in the air In 1943 the Royal Air Force recognised that training a vast amount of aircrew for a high attrition war was essential to an Allied victory and that the key to winning the battle of training was the Empire Air Training Scheme EATS 37 576 Australian aircrew graduated from the EATS Over 300 were killed whilst training for war and 9874 aircrew were killed or listed as missing while on active duty Those who fought under this scheme during World War II amounted to just 6 7 per cent of Australian service personnel serving overseas yet the aircrew losses amounted to almost 25 per cent of all the Australian fatalities during the war This made serving in EATS among the most hazardous duties of the war The Empire has an Answer was researched using more than 35 000 articles from 150 metropolitan regional and district newspapers and what materialised was a story of one of if not the greatest training programs the world has seen Follow the journey from the conception and implementation of the scheme through recruitment and basic training flight training and then into combat The individual accounts woven into the narrative provide a first hand experience of the triumphs and trials of typical airmen and airwomen who performed extraordinary feats in a time of great need The significant achievements and success of the Empire Air Training Scheme has for the most part been overlooked in our history until now

Japanese air raids on Darwin on 19 February 1942 are well known to most Australians although not perhaps to the rest of the world. What happened afterwards however remains unknown to many.
