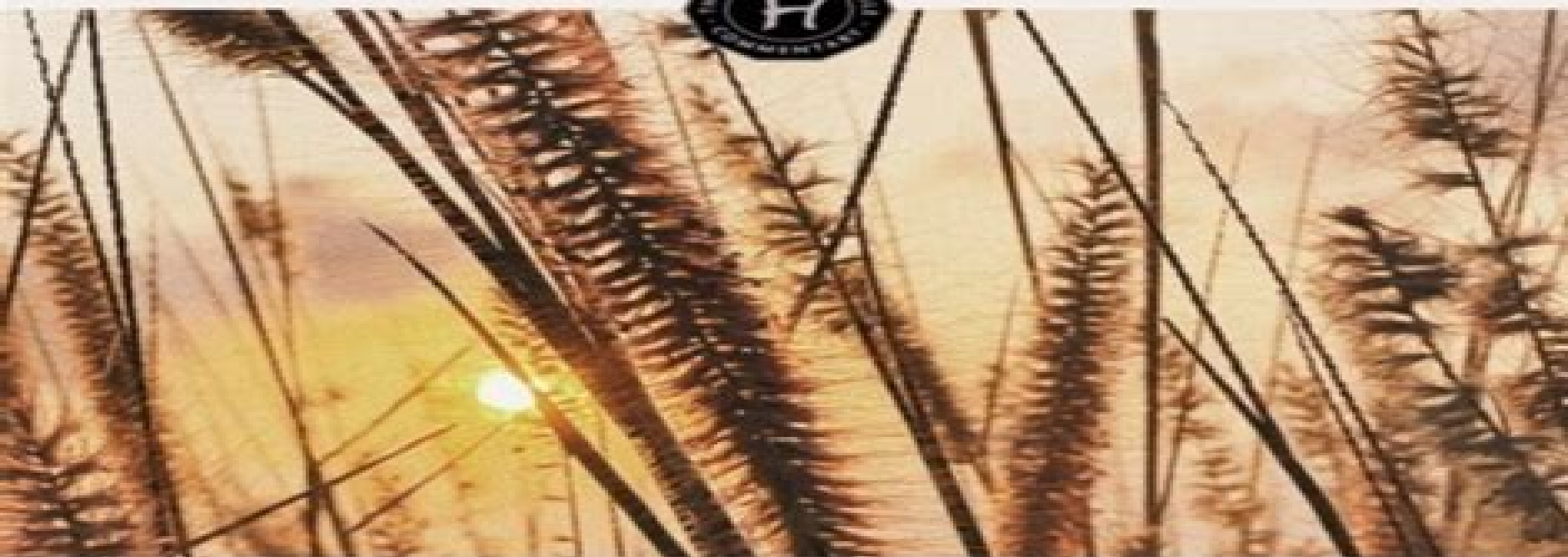

Oden, 2005-07-08 The early church valued the Gospel of Mark for its preservation of the apostolic voice and gospel narrative of Peter Yet the early church fathers very rarely produced sustained commentary on Mark In this ACCS volume the insights of Augustine of Hippo Clement of Alexandria Ephrem the Syrian and Cyril of Jerusalem join in a polyphony of interpretive voices from the second to the eighth century
