the criterion of importance insofar as I chose documents that I felt to be more or less essential Since I was also influenced by the double focus of this documentary history on events and issues I therefore included two types of documents the first consists of relatively short documents which are mostly either Inquisition proceedings Chapters V and IX or letters Chapters I VII and VIII and which primarily though not exclusively record various occurrences the second type consists of longer essays by Galileo Chapters II Ill IV and VI which discuss many of the central scientific and philosophical issues and have intrinsic importance independent of the affair Finally my goal of maximizing the autonomy of this volume suggested another reason for including some of these longer informative essays on the scientific issues Chapters IV and VI
