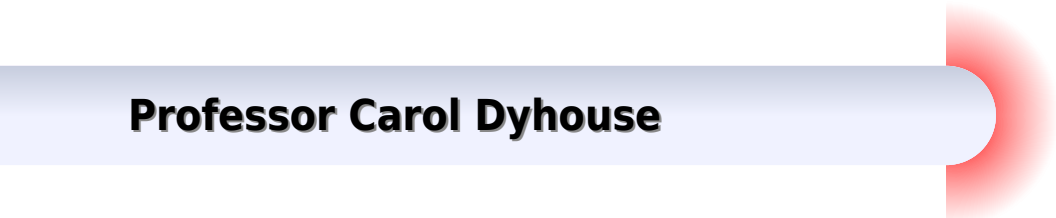

Rogers, 2014-09-15 In the Sex and Race series first published in the 1940s historian Joel Augustus Rogers questioned the concept of race the origins of racial differentiation and the root of the color problem Rogers surmised that a large percentage of ethnic differences are the result of sociological factors and in these volumes he gathered what he called the bran of history the uncollected unexamined history of black people in the hope that these neglected parts of history would become part of the mainstream body of Western history Drawing on a vast amount of research Rogers was attempting to point out the absurdity of racial divisions Indeed his belief in one race humanity precluded the idea of several different ethnic races The series marshals the data he had collected as evidence to prove his underlying humanistic thesis that people were one large family without racial boundaries Self trained and self published Rogers and his work were immensely popular and influential during his day even cited by Malcolm X The books are presented here in their original editions

Mysteries of Sex Mary P. Ryan, 2009-01-06 In a sweeping synthesis of American history Mary Ryan demonstrates how the meaning of male and female has evolved changed and varied over a span of 500 years and across major social and ethnic boundaries She traces how at select moments in history perceptions of sex difference were translated into complex and mutable patterns for differentiating women and men How those distinctions were drawn and redrawn affected the course of American history more generally Ryan recounts the construction of a modern gender regime that sharply divided male from female and created modes of exclusion and inequity The divide between male and female blurred in the twentieth century as women entered the public domain massed in the labor force and revolutionized private life This transformation in gender history serves as a backdrop for seven chronological chapters each of which presents a different problem in American history as a quandary of sex Ryan's bold analysis raises the possibility that perhaps if understood in their variety and mutability the differences of sex might lose the sting of inequality

Race Traffic Gunther Peck, 2024-12-10 Fantasies of white slavery and the narratives of victimhood they spawn form the foundation of racist ideology They also obscure the lived experience of trafficked servants and sailors in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries Gunther Peck moves deftly between the Atlantic and Mediterranean worlds to discover where and when people with light skin color came to see themselves as white Separating fact from fiction and paying close attention to the ideological work each performs Peck shows how laboring women and men leveraged their newfound whiteness to secure economic opportunity and political power Peck argues that whiteness emerged not as a claim of racial superiority but as a byproduct of wide ranging and rancorous public debate over trafficking and enslavement Even as whiteness became a legal category that signaled privilege trafficking and race remained tightly interwoven Those advocating for the value of whiteness invoked emotionally freighted victimhood claiming that so called white slavery was a

crime whose costs far exceeded those associated with the enslavement of African peoples across the Americas Peck helps us understand the chilling history that produced the racist ideology that still poisons our politics in the present day **Shades of Freedom** A. Leon Higginbotham Jr.,1998-06-11 Few individuals have had as great an impact on the law both its practice and its history as A Leon Higginbotham Jr A winner of the Presidential Medal of Freedom the nation s highest civilian honor he has distinguished himself over the decades both as a professor at Yale the University of Pennsylvania and Harvard and as a judge on the United States Court of Appeals But Judge Higginbotham is perhaps best known as an authority on racism in America not the least important achievement of his long career has been In the Matter of Color the first volume in a monumental history of race and the American legal process Published in 1978 this brilliant book has been hailed as the definitive account of racism slavery and the law in colonial America Now after twenty years comes the long awaited sequel In Shades of Freedom Higginbotham provides a magisterial account of the interaction between the law and racial oppression in America from colonial times to the present demonstrating how the one agent that should have guaranteed equal treatment before the law the judicial system instead played a dominant role in enforcing the inferior position of blacks The issue of racial inferiority is central to this volume as Higginbotham documents how early white perceptions of black inferiority slowly became codified into law Perhaps the most powerful and insightful writing centers on a pair of famous Supreme Court cases which Higginbotham uses to portray race relations at two vital moments in our history The Dred Scott decision of 1857 declared that a slave who had escaped to free territory must be returned to his slave owner Chief Justice Roger Taney in his notorious opinion for the majority stated that blacks were so inferior that they had no right which the white man was bound to respect For Higginbotham Taney s decision reflects the extreme state that race relations had reached just before the Civil War And after the War and Reconstruction Higginbotham reveals the Courts showed a pervasive reluctance if not hostility toward the goal of full and equal justice for African Americans and this was particularly true of the Supreme Court And in the Plessy v Ferguson decision which Higginbotham terms one of the most catastrophic racial decisions ever rendered the Court held that full equality in schooling or housing for instance was unnecessary as long as there were separate but equal facilities Higginbotham also documents the eloquent voices that opposed the openly racist workings of the judicial system from Reconstruction Congressman John R Lynch to Supreme Court Justice John Marshall Harlan to W E B Du Bois and he shows that ironically it was the conservative Supreme Court of the 1930s that began the attack on school segregation and overturned the convictions of African Americans in the famous Scottsboro case But today racial bias still dominates the nation Higginbotham concludes as he shows how in six recent court cases the public perception of black inferiority continues to persist In Shades of Freedom a noted scholar and celebrated jurist offers a work of magnificent scope insight and passion Ranging from the earliest colonial times to the present it is a superb work of history and a mirror to the American soul

White Women, Black Men Martha Hodes,2014-07-01 This book is the first to explore the history of a powerful category of illicit sex in America s past liaisons between Southern white women and black men Martha Hodes tells a series of stories about such liaisons in the years before the Civil War explores the complex ways in which white Southerners tolerated them in the slave South and shows how and why these responses changed with emancipation Hodes provides details of the wedding of a white servant woman and a slave man in 1681 an antebellum rape accusation that uncovered a relationship between an unmarried white woman and a slave and a divorce plea from a white farmer based on an adulterous affair between his wife and a neighborhood slave Drawing on sources that include courtroom testimony legislative petitions pardon pleas and congressional testimony she presents the voices of the authorities eyewitnesses and the transgressors themselves and these voices seem to say that in the slave South whites were not overwhelmingly concerned about such liaisons beyond the racial and legal status of the children that were produced Only with the advent of black freedom did the issue move beyond neighborhood dramas and into the arena of politics becoming a much more serious taboo than it had ever been before Hodes gives vivid examples of the violence that followed the upheaval of war when black men and white women were targeted by the Ku Klux Klan and unprecedented white rage and terrorism against such liaisons began to erupt An era of terror and lynchings was inaugurated and the legacy of these sexual politics lingered well into the twentieth century
