Many constitutional and civic issues have been debated throughout United States history by politicians, Americans, and historians. One of these issues is the role of the government in the economy. This debate has run the gamut from die hard supporters of mercantilism in the 1600s to supporters of laissez faire capitalism in the 1800s. The issue has pitted two presidents—Herbert Hoover and Franklin Delano Roosevelt against each other—as they debated how to handle the economic crisis of the Great Depression. While some deemed the interventions by the government, including the New Deal and rugged individualism, successful, others thought they were ineffective or misguided.

The 1920s, deemed as the "Roaring 20s", was a decade in the United States where the economy had flourished. As the nation's economy boomed and skyrocketed, the gap between the rich and poor was rapidly expanding. Not everyone was rewarded for the growing economic prosperity as there was an unequal distribution of wealth in society. In 1929, it was widely believed that American families that had incomes under \$2,500 were the minimum standard for decent living, yet 36,000 of the wealthiest families seemed to have earned just as much (Doc 1). The economic disparity allowed the wealthy 1% to dominate the hierarchy, leaving everyone else with little to no opportunity to make money. The country's GDP shrunk by 30% in a short span of time, thus creating an unstable economy.

Credit was a fairly new concept that Americans did not understand how it would drastically impact them. People who could not afford to pay for radios, refrigerators, cars, and other expensive goods began purchasing stocks by buying on the margin. Americans were reckless, hoping that it would gain more value in the near future and with the growing speculation, the stock market prices were left much higher than their actual value. Thus, on Black Tuesday, the stock market crashed and the rate of consumer debt escalated. Thousands of people made bank runs to withdraw their deposits, but American banks were failing as there was no more money to lend or loan. Consequently, after the stock market crash, from just below 5% to almost 25%, the unemployment rates in the labor force skyrocketed (Doc 3A). People were left jobless and in poverty. Factories were producing more goods than they could sell causing an overproduction of consumer goods with low demands in the manufacturing industry. Businesses began losing money whilst banks went bankrupt and unemployment rates continued to climb. The Great Depression marked the end of jazz and booze from the Roaring 20s with various efforts to be made by the government.

The American economic crisis was the beginning of President Herbert Hoover presidency in 1929. Hoover sought to reassure the American people that this prevailing issue would come to an end, but as the economy plummeted, he faced the soaring unemployment and suicide rates,
