suffered from John Hathorne's magisterial harshness and he maintained in consequence a lasting feud with the old Puritan official. But at his death English left daughters one of whom is said to have married the son of Justice John Hathorne whom English had declared he would never forgive. It is scarcely necessary to point out how clearly this foreshadows the final union of those hereditary foes the Pyncheons and Maules through the marriage of Phoebe and Holgrave. The romance however describes the Maules as possessing some of the traits known to have been characteristic of the Hawthornes for example so long as any of the race were to be found they had been marked out from other men not strikingly nor as with a sharp line but with an effect that was felt rather than spoken of by an hereditary characteristic of reserve.
