communities that Paul had worked so hard to establish Rather than running contrary to Jewish thought Paul s teaching that it was a life of faith rather than the observance of works of the law per se that led people to be accepted as righteous by God would have been regarded by most Jews as being fully in accordance with traditional Jewish belief What they would have found novel was Paul s claim that faith in the God of Israel was now to be equated with faith in Jesus as his Son or Christ faith and that through such a faith non Jews who did not observe the law could come to be as fully acceptable to God as those Jews who did Paul s redefinition of God and Judaism around Jesus as God s Son would have led many of his fellow Jews to conclude that he was proclaiming a God who was distinct from the God in whom the people of Israel had believed from time immemorial since that God was never thought to have such a Son and much less to have intended to exalt him to his right side as Lord of all after handing him over to death on a cross From the perspective of Paul and his fellow believers in Christ however the God of Israel and the God and Father of Jesus Christ were one and the same
