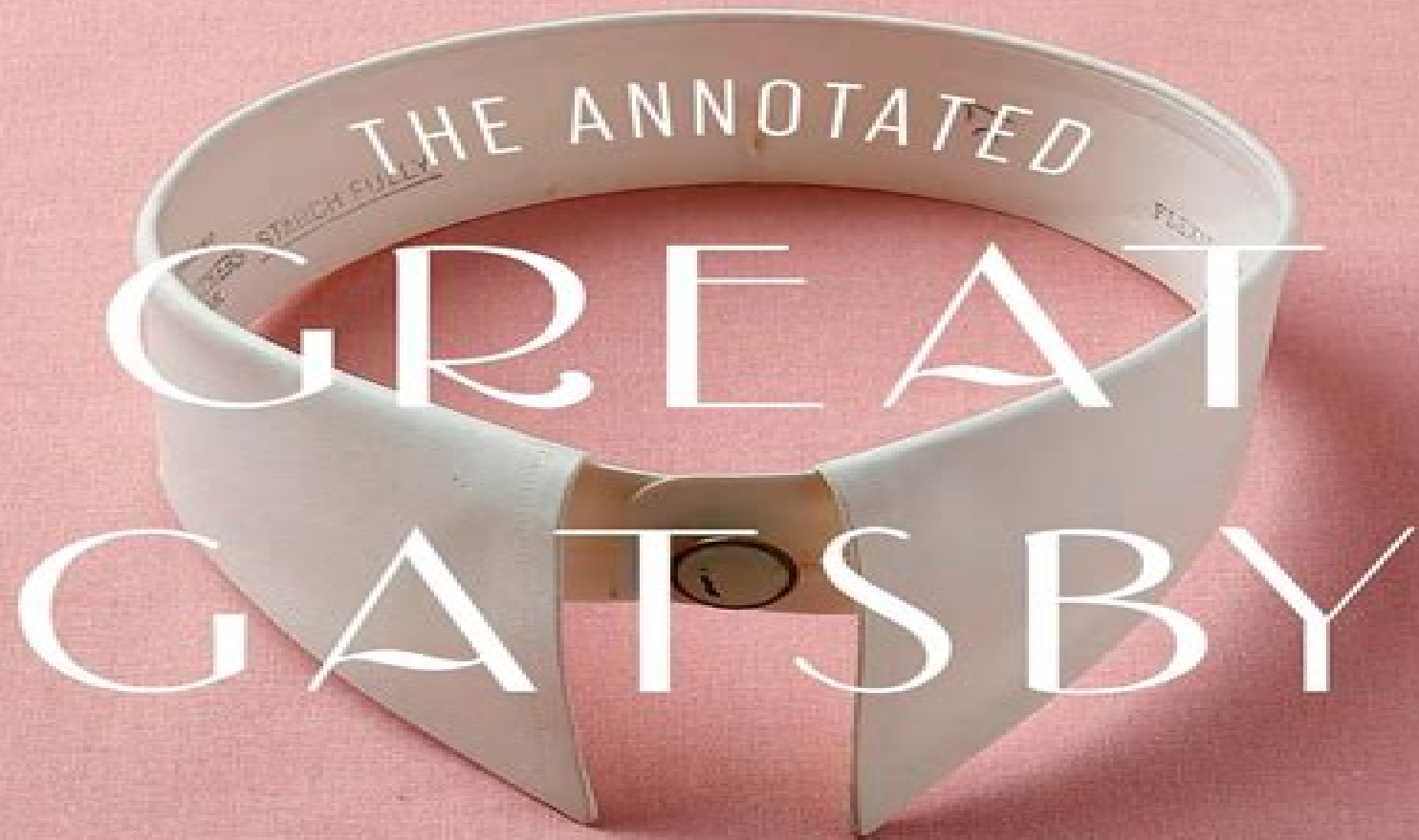

failed novel *The Great Gatsby* is now a cultural category. It's been adapted for ballet, film, games, opera, radio, television, and theater, and by other works of literature. What early critics saw as a period piece has always been about the central narratives of America itself: narratives about belonging, upward mobility, self-invention, what it means to be American vis-à-vis ethnicity and race, anxieties about immigration, and the many limitations imposed on women. Fitzgerald also shows us the destruction that accompanies these narratives, something for which audiences were not yet ready during Fitzgerald's lifetime.

F. Scott Fitzgerald (1896–1940) was born in St. Paul, Minnesota, and attended Princeton University before leaving in 1917 to join the army. He is said to have epitomized the Jazz Age, which he characterized as a generation grown up to find all gods dead, all wars fought, all faiths in man shaken. Among his works were five novels, six volumes of short stories, as well as a selection of autobiographical pieces.
