The Good Soldier Gary Mead, 2014 At the centenary of the commencement of the First World War here is a new edition of this evocative biography of Douglas Haig one of the most controversial commanders of the Great War

The Good Soldier Gary Mead, 2007 Haig commanded the British Army in France for much of the First World War and remained a robustly popular figure at the time of his death in 1928 It was only much later in the 1960s that he was recast in the role of the unthinking butcher sending his cheerful Tommies to the slaughter on the Somme and at Passchaendaele Even now revisionist military historians still pick over the bleached bones of Haig's campaigns but they evince little interest in Haig himself who remains an elusive and contradictory figure A competent if undistinguished career officer he reached the very top of his profession by dint of ambition and a passionate sense of duty towards army and nation A cavalryman to the core he enthusiastically supported tanks and other new technology on the battlefield He was also an intensely private man who could appear aloof and at a loss for words Still he devoted the last decade of his life to promoting the welfare of his soldiers and was instrumental in establishing both the British Legion and the rituals of Remembrance Sunday
