For each chapter in the textbook I've picked out the most important topics and presented them (for the most part) as questions below to aid you in preparing for the final exam. While a majority of this information was covered in class, and is thus in the slides, remember to reference your book as the slides do not always contain all of the necessary information about each topic. It is important to note that **NOT ALL INFORMATION BELOW WILL BE TESTED ON THE FINAL EXAM**. With that said, most of the information below will be tested on the final and if you can confidently and completely answer each of the questions below you should do extremely well.

As always, I **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** that you organize the information as you study and then study using recall instead of just re-reading. Additionally, many people find personal examples to be far easier to remember than simply trying to memorize facts. So, for example, in Chapter 1 you could think of different people you know to represent each of the four levels of analysis. That way, during the exam when a question is asked about the four levels you have a way of accessing and retrieving information about each level, and it's easy to remember because someone you know well represents each level. Regardless of how you choose to study, I hope your preparations go well!
