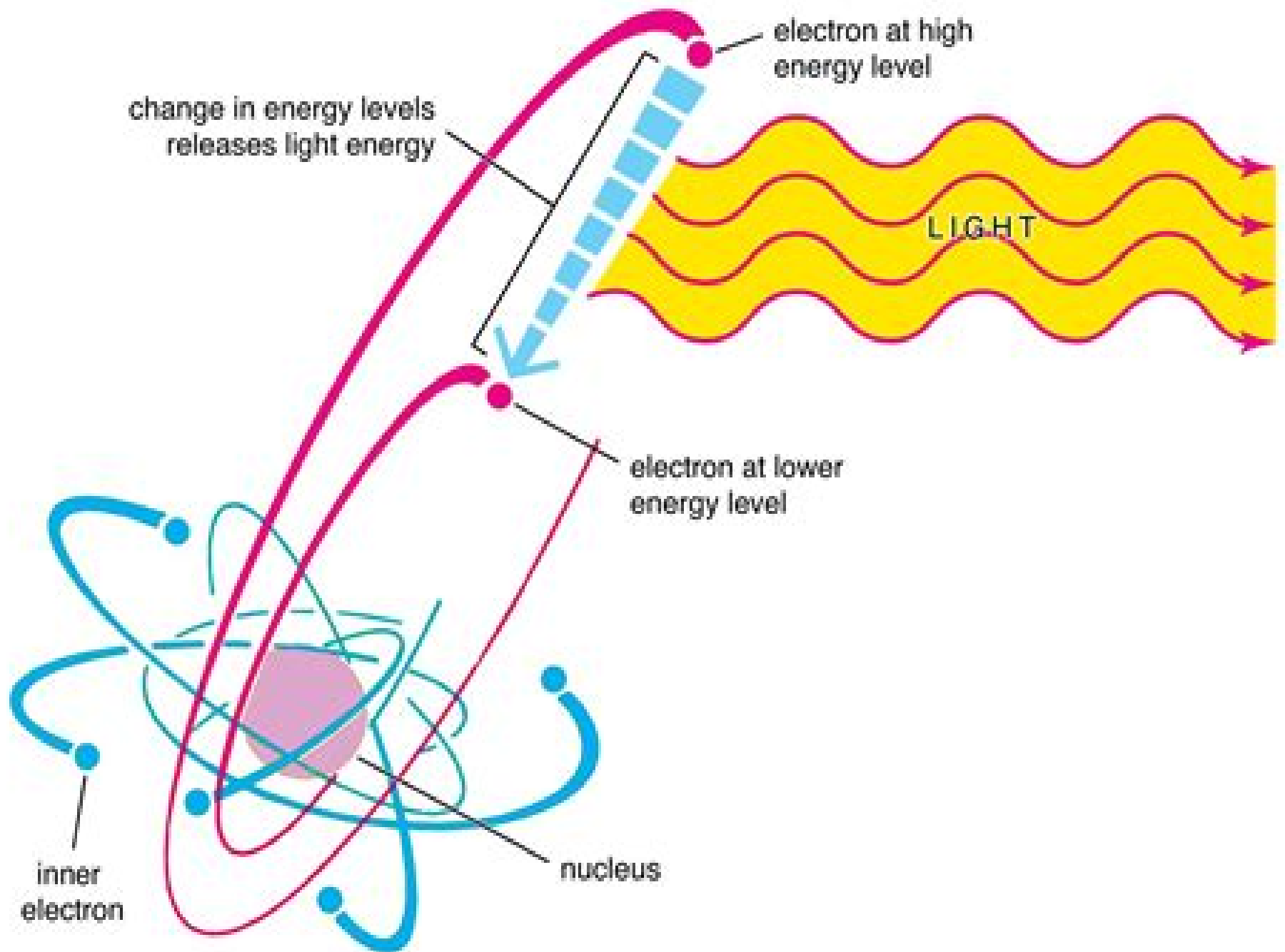

The Theory of Light and Matter Andrew Porter, 2010-09-20 These ten short stories explore loss and sacrifice in American suburbia In idyllic suburbs across the country from Philadelphia to San Francisco narrators struggle to find meaning or value in their lives because of or in spite of something that has happened in their pasts In Hole a young man reconstructs the memory of his childhood friend s deadly fall In The Theory of Light and Matter a woman second guesses her choice between a soul mate and a comfortable one Memories erode as Porter s characters struggle to determine what has happened to their loved ones and whether they are responsible Children and teenagers carry heavy burdens in these stories in River Dog the narrator cannot fully remember a drunken party where he suspects his older brother assaulted a classmate in Azul a childless couple craving the affection of an exchange student fails to set the boundaries that would keep him safe and in Departure a suburban teenage boy fascinated with the Amish makes a futile attempt to date a girl he can never be close to Memory often replaces absence in these stories as characters reconstruct the events of their pasts in an attempt to understand what they have chosen to keep These struggles lead to an array of secretive and escapist behavior as the characters united by middle class social pressures try to maintain a sense of order in their lives Drawing on the tradition of John Cheever these stories recall and revisit the landscape of American suburbia through the lens of a new generation

Wehner, 2012-12-06 The dynamical properties of solids have recently attracted renewed interest in connection with the increasing understanding of phase transitions and related phenomena In particular soft modes or more generally phonon anomalies seem to play an important role in structural and electronic phase transitions such as ferroelectric or superconducting transitions The understanding of the mechanisms responsible for the occurrence of unusually low frequencies in phonon spectra requires a detailed analysis of the microscopic forces governing the lattice vibrations Of particular importance is the influence of the electron lattice interaction in the adiabatic approximation which in many cases is the origin of peculiarities in the phonon self energy In this work the vibrational spectra of pure non metals and of those containing point defects are investigated In these materials the interrelation between the pseudo harmonic forces determining the phonon dispersion relations and the non linear anharmonic and electron phonon forces as they act in infrared and Raman spectra is most obvious and can be

quantitatively analysed in terms of appropriate models The main task is to arrive at a physically correct treatment of electronic degrees of freedom as for example in an electronic shell model which leads to the description of phonon spectra in terms of long range polarizabilities and short range deformabilities The purpose of our review is to stimulate further investigations which we hope will result in explicit relations between the parameters of the semi microscopic models and the matrix elements from the electronic band structure

Matrix Theory of Photoelasticity Pericles S. Theocaris, E.E. Gdoutos, 2013-06-29 Photoelasticity as an experimental method for analyzing stress fields in mechanics was developed in the early thirties by the pioneering works of Mesnager in France and Coker and Filon in England Almost concurrently F ppl Mesmer and Oppel in Germany contributed significantly to what turned out to be an amazing development Indeed in the fifties and sixties a tremendous number of scientific papers and monographs appeared all over the world dealing with various aspects of the method and its applications in experimental stress analysis All of these contributions were based on the so called Neumann Maxwell stress optical law they were developed by means of the classical methods of vector analysis and analytic geometry using the conventional light vector concept This way of treating problems of

mechanics by photoelasticity indicated many shortcomings and drawbacks of this classical method especially when three dimensional problems of elasticity had to be treated and when complicated load and geometry situations existed Meanwhile the idea of using the Poincare sphere for representing any polarization profile in photoelastic applications was introduced by Robert in France and Aben in the USSR in order to deal with problems of polarization of light passing through a series of optical elements retarders and/or rotators Although the Poincare sphere presentation of any polarization profile constitutes a powerful and elegant method it exhibits the difficulty of requiring manipulations in three dimensional space on the surface of the unit sphere However other graphical methods have been developed to bypass this difficulty
