

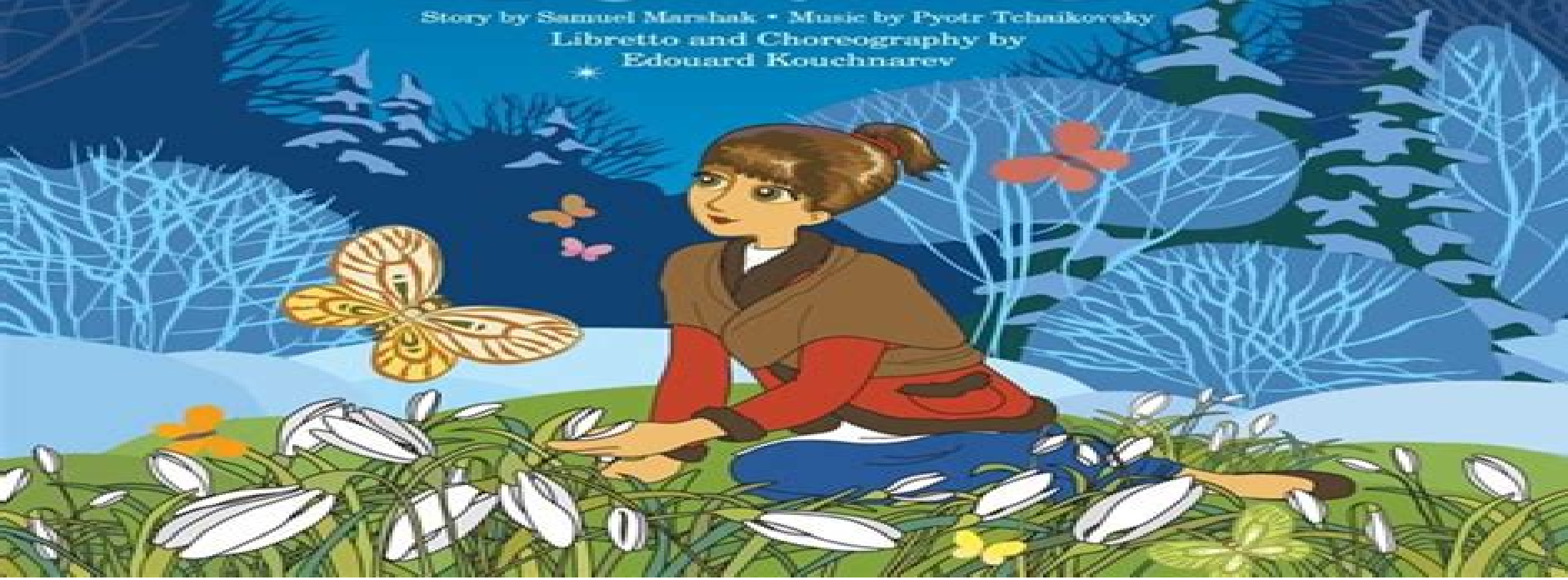

Marshak, 2000 Samuel Marshak was born in 1887 His start in literary life he owed largely to Maxim Gorky in the circle of whose family he spent part of his youth He first appeared in print in 1907 with lyrics of his own and translations of foreign poets Marshak has been most prolific in the field of juvenile literature He inculcates respect for the man who knows his job respect for creative work Marshak also wrote several plays based on Russian fairy tales and designed for the juvenile stage including Twelve Months Written in a light and witty vein Twelve Months portrays twelve wise and just rulers of nature and two girls of opposite type the one good whom they help and the other bad whom they punish The play was awarded a Stalin Prize in 1946 **The Irresistible Fairy Tale** Jack Zipes, 2012 A provocative new theory about fairy tales from one of the world's leading authorities If there is one genre that has captured the imagination of people in all walks of life throughout the world it is the fairy tale Yet we still have great difficulty understanding how it originated evolved and spread or why so many people cannot resist its appeal no matter how it changes or what form it takes In this book renowned fairy tale expert Jack Zipes presents a provocative new theory about why fairy tales were created and retold and why they became such an indelible and infinitely adaptable part of cultures around the world Drawing on cognitive science evolutionary theory anthropology psychology literary theory and other fields Zipes presents a nuanced argument about how fairy tales originated in ancient oral cultures how they evolved through the rise of literary culture and print and how in our own time they continue to change through their adaptation in an ever growing variety of media In making his case Zipes considers a wide range of fascinating examples including fairy tales told collected and written by women in the nineteenth century Catherine Breillat's film adaptation of Perrault's Bluebeard and contemporary fairy tale drawings paintings sculptures and photographs that critique canonical print versions While we may
