habits physical appearance lives and political careers of the first Roman emperors It mentions details that other sources do not For example Suetonius is the main source on the life of Caligula his uncle Claudius as well as the heritage of Vespasian the relevant sections of the Annals by his contemporary Tacitus having been lost Suetonius made a reference in this work to Chrestus which may refer to Christ During the book on Nero Suetonius mentions Christians see Historicity of Jesus Like many of his contemporaries Suetonius took omens seriously and carefully includes reports of omens portending Imperial births accessions and deaths
