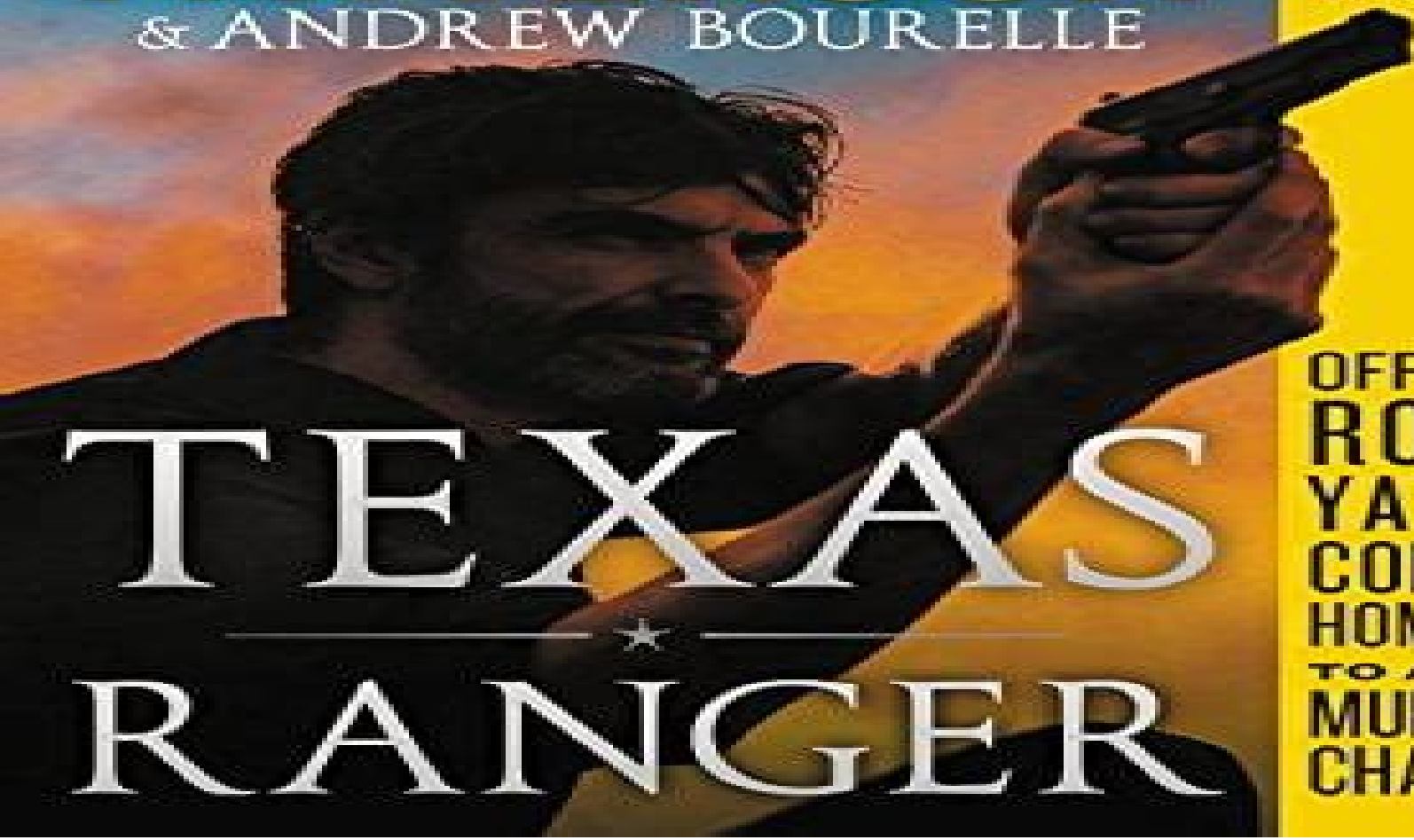

The Texas Rangers Mike Cox, 2024-05-01 A lively enlightening history of one of the oldest most esteemed law enforcement agencies in America Booklist Starting in 1821 with just a handful of men the Rangers first purpose was to keep settlers safe from the feared and gruesome Karankawa Indians a cannibalistic tribe that wandered the Texas territory As the influx of settlers grew the attacks increased and it became clear that a much larger better trained force was necessary From their tumultuous beginning to their decades of fighting outlaws Comanche Mexican soldados and banditos as well as Union soldiers the Texas Rangers became one of the fiercest law enforcement groups in America In a land as spread out and sparsely populated as the west itself the Rangers had unique law enforcement responsibilities and challenges The story of the Texas Rangers is as controversial as it is heroic Often accused of vigilante style racism and murder they enforced the law with a heavy hand But above all they were perhaps the defining force for the stabilization and the creation of Texas From Stephen Austin in the early days through the Civil War the first eighty years of the Texas Rangers is nothing less than phenomenal setting the foundation for the Texas Rangers that keep Texas safe today Richly detailed This modern masterpiece does full justice to both the reality and the myth of the Texas Rangers a great organization of which I was honored to be a part for 27 years Joaquin Jackson Texas Ranger Ret author of One Ranger A Memoir Texas Ranger John B. by transitioning from gunfighters to criminal investigators Steeped in tradition reluctant to change the agency was reduced to its nadir in the depths of the Depression the victim of slashed appropriations an antagonistic governor and mediocre personnel Harris and Sadler document the further and final change that followed when in 1935 the Texas Rangers were moved from the governor's control to the newly created Department of Public Safety This proved a watershed in the Rangers history marking their transformation into a modern law enforcement agency the elite investigative force that they remain to this day *Children's Catalog* H.W. Glasrud, Harold J. Weiss Jr, 2024-10-15 The first systematic inquiry into the Texas Rangers did not begin until 1935 with Walter Prescott Webb's publication *The Texas Rangers* Since then numerous works have appeared on the Rangers but no volume has been published before that covers the various historians of the Rangers and their approaches to the topic Editors Bruce A Glasrud and Harold J Weiss Jr gather essays that profile individual historians of the Texas Rangers explore themes and issues in Ranger history and comprise archival research biographies and autobiographies Several approaches in Texas historiography have influenced the writings on the Texas Rangers and serve to organize the chapters in the volume Traditionalists Chuck Parsons Stephen L Moore and Bob Alexander stress the revered happenings in the nineteenth century that brought about the Lone Star state and its empire building Ranger force To these historical writers the Texas Rangers were part of a golden age Revisionists Robert M Utley Louis R Sadler and Charles H Harris pull back from this adulation emphasize the importance of overlooked ethnic and racial groups and point out misbehavior on the part of Rangers They also want to separate fact from fiction Some Ranger historians Frederick Wilkins and Mike Cox straddle both traditional and revisionist approaches in their works The final group Cultural Constructionalists Gary Clayton Anderson Am rico Paredes and Monica Mu oz Martinez continue the work of Revisionists and focus on an interconnected past that includes theoretical approaches and the study of memory and regional identities Several themes emerge throughout the book One is how the Rangers changed from unorganized mounted militia dragoons in the modern sense to organized cavalry forces with six shooter firepower who

served as a military arm of the state and nation A second is how the dichotomous views of the Rangers as either patriot warriors or bloody avengers left their imprint on Anglo and Hispanic society This divergent examination especially derived from incidents in the US Mexican War the period from 1910 to 1920 and the lower Rio Grande valley in the 1960s And yet another theme is how the Rangers first resisted and fought against yet ultimately absorbed all creeds and colors into their ranks over two hundred years as they evolved into police officers Anglo Black Hispanic Indian and women Rangers Texas Rangers, Ranchers, and Realtors Thomas O. McDonald, 2021-03-25 A native Georgian James Hughes Callahan 1812 1856 migrated to Texas to serve in the Texas Revolution in exchange for land In Seguin Texas where he settled he met and married a divorcee Sarah Medissa Day 1822 1856 The lives of these two Texas pioneers and their extended family would become so entwined in the events and experiences of the nascent nation and state that their story represents a social history of nineteenth century Texas From his arrival as a sergeant with the Georgia Battalion through the ill fated 1855 expedition that bears his name to his shooting death in a feud with a neighbor Callahan was a soldier a Texas Ranger a rancher and a land developer at every turn making his mark on the evolving Guadalupe River Basin Separately Sarah's family's journey reflected the experience of many immigrants to Texas after its war of independence Thomas O McDonald traces the pair's respective paths to their meeting then follows as together they contend with conflict troublesome social mores the emergence of new industries and the taming of the land along the way helping to shape the Texas culture we know today With a sharp eye for character and detail and with a wealth of material at his command author Thomas O McDonald tells a story as crackling with life as it is steeped in scholarly research In these pages the lives of the Callahan and Day families become a canvas on which the history of Texas from revolution frontier defense and Indian wars to Anglo settlement and emerging legal and social systems dramatically inexorably unfolds *Texas Ranger Captain William L. Wright* Richard McCaslin, 2021-10-15 William L Wright 1868 1942 was born to be a Texas Ranger and hard work made him a great one Wright tried working as a cowboy and farmer but it did not suit him Instead he became a deputy sheriff and then a Ranger in 1899 battling a mob in the Laredo Smallpox Riot policing both sides in the Reese Townsend Feud and winning a gunfight at Cotulla His need for a better salary led him to leave the Rangers and become a sheriff He stayed in that office longer than any of his predecessors in Wilson County keeping the peace during the so called Bandit Wars investigating numerous violent crimes and surviving being stabbed on the gallows by the man he was hanging When demands for Ranger reform peaked he was appointed as a captain and served for most of the next twenty years retiring in 1939 after commanding dozens of Rangers Wright emerged unscathed from the Canales investigation enforced Prohibition in South Texas and policed oil towns in West Texas as well as tackling many other legal problems When he retired he was the only Ranger in service who had worked under seven governors Wright has also been honored as an inductee into the Texas Ranger Hall of Fame at Waco

Brice,2014-08-15 Historians Chuck Parsons and Donaly E Brice present a complete picture of N O Reynolds 1846 1922 a Texas Ranger who brought a greater respect for the law in Central Texas Reynolds began as a sergeant in famed Company D Frontier Battalion in 1874 He served honorably during the Mason County Hoo Doo War and was chosen to be part of Major John B Jones s escort riding the frontier line In 1877 he arrested the Horrells who were feuding with their neighbors the Higgins party thus ending their Lampasas County feud Shortly thereafter he was given command of the newly formed Company E of Texas Rangers Also in 1877 the notorious John Wesley Hardin was captured N O Reynolds was given the responsibility to deliver Hardin to trial in

Comanche return him to a safe jail during his appeal and then escort him safely to the Huntsville penitentiary Reynolds served as a Texas Ranger until he retired in 1879 at the rank of lieutenant later serving as City Marshal of Lampasas and then County Sheriff of Lampasas County
