Extractive Industry Indigenisation in Zimbabwe Kennedy Manduna, 2025-09-25 This book explains how and why Zimbabwe's extractive industry Indigenisation over promised its benefits yet under delivered upon implementation This book traces the history of uneven development in Zimbabwe from the initial days of colonialism to the present using the extractive industry as the unit of analysis to carve out a granular and empirical analysis of the preponderance of transnational corporate control and ownership in the country Indigenisation of Zimbabwe's extractive industries was intended to address mining inequalities by transferring wealth from rich non Indigenous mining capital to disadvantaged Indigenous citizens and communities This policy however was a response to political economic and social crises posed by the international isolation of Zimbabwe's government following the controversial Fast Track Land Reform Programme in 2000 2003 An intervention therefore which promised to address inequalities has thus been hampered by corruption co optation and collusion which has led to it not only failing to address uneven development but in actual fact worsening the situation By examining the hidden structures and infrastructures of power capital and minerals and placing extractive industry Indigenisation in capitalism this book makes a crucial scholarly contribution to the renewed and burgeoning debates around the resurgence of resource nationalism in general and the struggle for economic sovereignty in particular This book steers readers more broadly to look for new and diversified ways of empowering Indigenous populations and their communities through mining Indigenisation in ways that do not threaten economic and political stability This book will be of great interest to students and scholars of the extractive industries natural resource management African politics and African development

Making Politics in Zimbabwe's Second Republic Gordon Moyo, Kirk Helliker, 2023-05-16 The book provides a fresh and innovative interpretation of the new government of Zimbabwe led by Emmerson Mnangagwa which emerged in late 2017 after the downfall of Robert Mugabe It demonstrates

the contradictory character of the Mnangagwa government involving both continuities and discontinuities in relation to Mugabe's regime. The temptation amongst Zimbabwean scholars has been to focus on the continuities and to dismiss the significance of any discontinuities notably reform measures. This book adopts an alternative approach by identifying and focusing specifically on the existence of a formative project of the Mnangagwa's Second Republic further analysing its political significance as well as risks and limitations. While doing so the book covers topics such as reform measures reconciliation transitional justice corruption the media agriculture devolution and the debt crisis as well as health and education. Discussing the limitations of these different reform measures the book highlights that any scholarly failure to identify the risks of the project leads to an incomplete understanding of what constitutes the Mnangagwa's Second Republic. The book appeals to students scholars and researchers of Zimbabwean and African studies political science and international relations as well as policymakers interested in a better understanding of political reform processes.

Transitional Justice and Socio-Economic Rights in Zimbabwe Prosper Maguchu, 2019-07-26 This book addresses the issue of corruption as a socio economic rights concern at a national level. Zimbabwe's widespread corruption inhibited its development in all aspects. It weakened institutions especially those called upon to arbitrate political and economic contests leading to potential human rights violations. However Zimbabwe saw a change of government in November 2017. Due to this there seemed to be an opening to work towards reform in relation to the anti corruption architecture. Specifically the new era provides an opportunity to review how accountability mechanisms including but not limited to amnesties truth commissions institutional reforms and prosecutions can address corruption as a socio economic rights violation. As the new government still tries to address competing priorities many moving parts and various matrixes this volume in the International Criminal Justice Series provides a timely frame for revisiting the debate and developing the strategic thinking regarding transitional justice options in Zimbabwe. It will be of great interest to practitioners policy makers scholars and students in the fields of anti corruption socio economic and human rights and transitional justice.
