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I believe that the E Symposium on Industrial and Systems Engineering (ISE) should promote an integrated learning environment for an interdisciplinary approach through its academic advisory programs that provide mathematics, statistics, and computer systems as additional rather than engineering subjects. Mathematical concepts have been applied in previous research (Hyndy, 1999) where research groups have synthesized the engineering and mathematical sciences in mathematics. I believe that ISE should have the opportunity to expand on the knowledge I was introduced to as "Math Week." I am excited to be able present to that learning system as the E Symposium on Industrial and Systems Engineering through the integration of the academic knowledge and my personal/industry-related studies as research in an interdisciplinary environment.
