Mahoney, 2014-12-22 Finally a collection of story starters that will capture the attention of any reluctant writer Here are 35 writing prompts each with a photo and a weird story starter The first page has a photo of a Painted Lady butterfly drinking nectar from a flower The prompt says I heard a voice very quiet and sad Help me please Somebody help me And two lined pages follow for you or your student or your child to write this story of a butterfly in danger What threatens her That is for you to decide using imagination and creativity and wonder Another prompt shows a photo of a bird among leaf litter with this prompt Hopping left and right she searched for insects to take back to her chicks But she never saw the snake until it was right beside her That would make a thrilling story of danger and survival of surprise and decisions Another story shows a photo of a bench nestled among the branches of a large tree with this prompt The hiker saw the bench and took a seat He never suspected that a nearby tree would attack Ha A story told from the perspective of a carnivorous tree That is different You will find lots of imaginative story starters where odd characters tell the story a ladybug a snake a lost ring a hungry hawk a beetle a squirrel a mouse a honeybee a bird a surfacing worm a leaf a squirrel an eagle a lizard a hummingbird a scorpion a grasshopper a rock a raccoon an ant a flower and more You must think differently when you re writing from the perspective of a critter that lives its life underground a worm or a critter that spends much of its day in the skies an eagle These activities are much different from the typical first person human perspective story writing This is new different Try it out and see where your imagination goes
