Discussion

A discussion text presents all sides of an issue. It outlines the issue and makes points for and against. It often concludes by stating an opinion.

Title	A short statement about the topic	→
Overview	A brief statement of the author's view of the main topic	
Reasons	The points supporting the author's view; the author's view may be supported or not	
Conclusion	Summarizing statement about the topic	

Report

A report presents information about an object, animal, person or place.

Title	Summarize the thing
Introduction	Tells what the thing is and is told something about it
Description	Tells what the thing has, what it looks like, where it lives or how it grows (provides information about it)
Conclusion	Shows a helpful statement on the thing

Recount

A **recount** tells about events that have happened to you or other people. Recounts can be fiction or non-fiction.

Title	A brief name for the experience or event
Orientation	Tells where and when the event happened and why you were there
Events	Tells the events in the order they happened
Ending	Tells how the experience ended and how it changed you and how about it

Procedural

A procedure that tells how to do something or how to make something.

Title	Indicate what is being investigated
Goal	State what the procedure aims to produce
Materials	Describe or list what is required to complete the procedure
Method	Describe step-by-step how to complete the procedure
Conclusion	State or check if the procedure was successful

Narrative

A narrative retells events. Narratives are often fiction, eg. stories, but may include some information. Each part or event is in a separate paragraph.

Title	Usually appears at the top of the beginning of the reader.
Setting	The starting point of the story. It tells where, when the action and what the culture is.
Complication (beginning event or problem)	What starts the story. The action and conflict are in some problem. The events that happen on the story line to make the problem.
Resolution	Tells how the problem is solved.
Ending	Tells what has come from the experience.

Explanation

Explanation texts tell how something works. They are used in all the arts and sciences. Explanations have five parts to their framework:

Title	This is a short statement or statement about the topic.
Definition	Defines the thing or process.
Description	Describes the parts or elements in the process.
How does it work or function?	Explains the parts or elements in the process.
Application	Purpose of the subject, machine or process.
