Washington can be divided into 5 land regions.

The Coastal Range

Land Features:

rainforests, Olympic Mountains, Mount Baker. "Greatest weight of living mass per acre, in the world"

Economy: Small towns rely on tourism. Lumber mills and commercial fishing has declined in this region.

The Puget Sound Lowlands

Land Features: Lowlands make up plains and valleys.

Cities include: Seattle, Everett, Bellingham, Tacoma, Bellevue

Economy: Ship, water transport are important for shipping.

Costa vary and Microsoft is the world's largest corporation.

Agriculture: Skagitnum valley.

Columbia and Cowlitz counties include rich farming areas.

The Cascade Range

Land Features: High volcanic peaks, forests and glaciers. Mt. St. Helens, Mt. Rainier, Mt. Adams.

Economy: Large resorts, manufacturing companies.

National Parks: North Cascades and Mt. Rainier bring in 1,000's of visitors per year.

The Rocky Mountain Region

Land Features: steep hills are the foothills of the Rocky Mountains.

Economy: People rely on farming, mining land and coal, ranching and lumbering.

The Columbia Plateau

Land Features: high, flat plateau covers most of eastern WA. Drier land in the state. Includes gravel and aggregate.

Agriculture: apples, cherries, grapes, corn.

Cities: Spokane is the largest city and is the commercial, financial and medical center of the region.

Campbell, 1996 This report describes students reading achievements at grades 4 8 and 12 and within various subgroups of the general population State level results are presented for individual states that chose to participate in the 1994 Trial State Assessment Chapter 1 presents an overview of the 1994 NAEP reading assessment and sample questions and responses Chapter 2 provides overall average proficiency results for the nation regions subgroups of students and jurisdictions participating in the Trial State Assessment Chapter 3 describes students reading performance in terms of achievement levels Chapter 4 focuses on cross state comparisons of proficiency results from the state by state assessment at grade 4 Chapter 5 describes contextual factors related to students reading achievement Chapter 6 describes specific abilities demonstrated by students in the NAEP reading assessment and reports student performance when reading for different purposes The most striking finding from the 1994 assessment is that the average reading proficiency of 12th grade students declined significantly from 1992 to 1994 Other major findings include

- 1 the decline in average proficiency among 12th graders between 1992 and 1994 was concentrated among lower performing students
- 2 reading proficiency at all three grade levels was higher on average for students whose parents had more education
- 3 at all three grade levels female students had higher average reading proficiencies than male students and
- 4 students who reported having a greater array of literacy materials in their homes displayed higher average reading achievement
