Street Life in London Emily Kathryn Morgan, 2014 This book examines the 1877 78 publication Street Life in London by journalist Adolphe Smith and photographer John Thomson Street Life in London aimed to reveal through the innovative use of photography and essays the conditions of a life of poverty in London Now regarded as a pioneering photo text and a foundational work of socially conscious photography one of the most significant and far reaching photobooks in the medium s history The Photobook A History Street Life in London did not achieve commercial success in its own time In Street Life in London we see the start but not the conclusion of a conversation between text and image in the service of education reportage and social justice This book is the first ever in depth analysis of the genesis development and context of Smith and Thomson s groundbreaking publication
