Annualized quarterly change in U.S. GDP



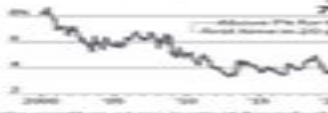
Contributions to the change in GDP from the second quarter to the third in 2022



Final sales to private domestic purchasers, change from previous quarter



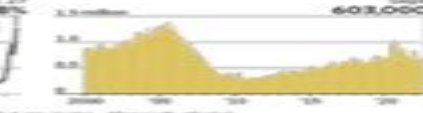
Average rate on a 30-year fixed mortgage
