

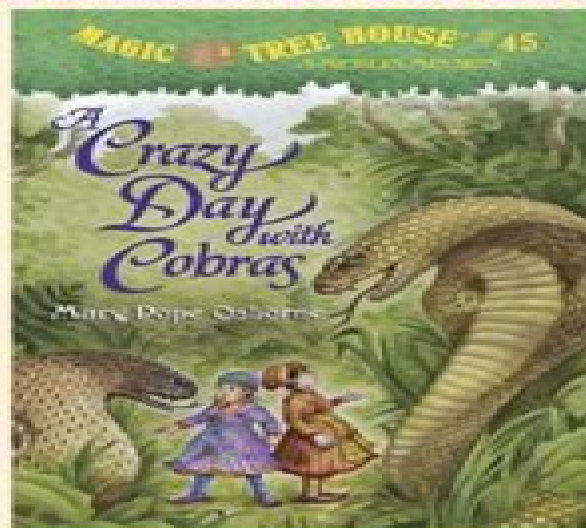

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The Boundaries of the Literary Archive Lisa Stead, 2016-03-23 This volume offers new and challenging interdisciplinary approaches to the use and study of literary archives Interrogating literary and archival methodology and foregrounding new forms of textual scholarship the collection includes essays from both academics and archivists to address the full complexity of the study of modern literary archives The authors examine the increasing prominence of archives and their importance to the interdisciplinary study of textual history in the 21st century exploring both emerging and established areas of literary history The book is marked by its attention to four distinct core threads that allow the authors to traverse a range of historical periods and literary figures archival theory and textual production authorial legacies and digital cultures gender issues in the archive and the practical concerns of archival research and curatorship By offering an investigation of material from a range of historical periods within distinct methodological groupings the volume seeks to encourage interplay between scholars working in different fields around similar essential questions of methodology whilst presenting a rich account of archives worldwide

Place-making for the Imagination: Horace Walpole and Strawberry Hill Marion Harney, 2016-04-08 Drawing together landscape architecture and literature Strawberry Hill the celebrated eighteenth century Gothic villa and garden beside the River Thames is an autobiographical site where we can read the story of its creator Horace Walpole This man of taste created private resonances pleasure and entertainment a collusion of the historic the visual and the sensory Above all it expresses the inseparable integration of house and setting and of the architecture with the collection all specific to one individual a unity that is relevant today to all architects landscape designers and garden and country house enthusiasts Avoiding the straightforward architectural description of previous texts this beautifully illustrated book reveals the Gothic villa and associated landscape to be inspired by theories that stimulate *The Pleasures of the Imagination* articulated in the series of essays by Joseph Addison 1672 1719 published in the *Spectator* 1712 Linked to this argument it proposes that the concepts behind the designs for Strawberry Hill are not based around architectural precedent but around eighteenth century aesthetics theories antiquarianism and matters of Taste Using architectural quotations from Gothic tombs Walpole expresses the mythical idea that it was based on monastic foundations with visual links to significant historical figures and events in English history The book explains for the first time the reasons for its creation which have never been adequately explored or fully understood in previous publications The book develops an argument that Walpole was the first to define theories on Gothic architecture in his *Anecdotes of Painting* 1762 71 Similarly innovative *The History of the Modern Taste in Gardening* 1780 is one of the first to attempt a history and theory of gardening The research uniquely evaluates how these theories found expression at Strawberry Hill This reassessment of the villa and its associated l *Annual List of Books Added to the Public Library of Cincinnati* Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County, 1879 The Forgotten Fourdrinier Peter Simpson, 2017-01-18 This book is a meticulously researched but very readable story of Huguenot Paul

Fourdrinier's journey from being an apprentice in Holland to a highly recognized printmaker in London in the eighteenth century. Paul is almost forgotten and artistically underrated but was an accomplished copper engraver who founded the English Fourdrinier dynasty which produced the developers of the Fourdrinier papermaking machine and the mother of Cardinal Newman. The reader will be immersed in his world and his connections to aristocrats, artists, and great projects of the age, including the development of Palladian neoclassical architecture, the Foundlings Hospital, and the Savannah colony in Georgia, and renowned talents such as the sculptor Rysbrack, painter Hogarth, designer William Kent, and composer George Frederick Handel. As well as the great and powerful, we meet the eccentrics: George Vertue, Horace Walpole, the reverend Stephen Duck, Batty Langley, courtesan Teresia Constantia Phillips, and the curious affair of Mary Toft who convinced half the nation that she had given birth to rabbits. This was a time of exciting intellectual development. The combination of copper engraving and printing along with the removal of state censorship and the institution of copyright led to a wave of information and learning not dissimilar to the impact of the Internet. The institution of commercial companies and banks foreshadowed the Industrial Revolution and made possible projects such as Charles Labeyrie's first Westminster Bridge, the building of Regency Bath, and James Gibbs' Radcliffe Camera in Oxford, all engraved by Fourdrinier on behalf of their creators. In his shop in Whitehall, he developed master engravings of uncommon size and shapes for customers including the Earls of Burlington and Pembroke and engraved for Thomas Wright, the astronomer who first defined galaxies, and William Chambers, who propelled Chinese fashion into Georgian design. This is a fascinating book from beginning to end.

Despite the fame of individual members like Henrietta Bartlett or Mary Hyde Eccles, there is no sustained study of the Club's work and legacy. This Element makes this history broadly accessible and focuses on how members shared knowledge and expertise and provided a space for legitimacy and self-growth in a period where women's access to formal education and academic institutions was limited. By making this network visible through an examination of archival records, library catalogs, and pamphlets, this project positions the Club as a case study for a more thorough examination of the ways that intersectional identities can make visible or obscure whose intellect, money, and resources have shaped the study of rare books in the United States. *Arts and Crafts Architecture* Maureen Meister, 2014-11-04 This book offers the first full-scale examination of the architecture associated with the Arts and Crafts movement that spread throughout New England at the turn of the twentieth century. Although interest in the Arts and Crafts movement has grown since the 1970s, the literature on New England has focused on craft production. Meister traces the history of the movement from its origins in mid-nineteenth-century England to its arrival in the United States and describes how Boston architects, including H. H. Richardson, embraced its tenets in the 1870s and 1880s. She then turns to the next generation of designers, examining buildings by twelve of the region's most prominent architects: eleven men and a woman who assumed leadership roles in the Society of Arts and Crafts founded in Boston in 1897. Among them are Ralph Adams Cram, Lois Lilley Howe, Charles Maginnis, and H. Langford Warren. They promoted designs based on historical precedent and the region's heritage while encouraging well-executed ornament. Meister also discusses revered cultural personalities who influenced the architects, notably Ralph Waldo Emerson and art historian Charles Eliot Norton, as well as contemporaries who shared their concerns, such as Louis Brandeis. Conservative though the architects were in the styles they favored, they also were forward-looking, blending Arts and Crafts values with Progressive Era idealism. Open to new materials and building types, they made lasting contributions, with many of their designs now landmarks honored in cities and towns across New England. *The Juggler of Notre Dame and the Medievalizing of Modernity*. Jan M. Ziolkowski, 2018-08-29 This ambitious and vivid study in six volumes explores the journey of a single electrifying story from its first incarnation in a medieval French poem through its prolific rebirth in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. *The Juggler of Notre Dame* tells how an entertainer abandons the world to join a monastery but is suspected of blasphemy after dancing his devotion before a statue of the Madonna. In the crypt, he is saved when the statue, delighted by his skill, miraculously comes to life. Jan Ziolkowski tracks the poem from its medieval roots to its rediscovery in late nineteenth-century Paris, before its translation into English in Britain and the United States. The visual influence of the tale on Gothic revivalism and vice versa in America is

carefully documented with lavish and inventive illustrations and Ziolkowski concludes with an examination of the explosion of interest in The Juggler of Notre Dame in the twentieth century and its place in mass culture today Volume 3 The American Middle Ages hinges upon two figures influenced by the juggler Henry Adams scion of Presidents and distinguished cultural historian whose works contributed to the rise of medievalism in America during the Gilded Age and Ralph Adams Cram the architect whose vision of Gothic accounts directly or indirectly for the campuses of West Point Princeton Yale Chicago Notre Dame and many other universities across America The Juggler of Notre Dame and the Medievalizing of Modernity is a rich case study for the reception of the Middle Ages in modernity Spanning centuries and continents the medieval period is understood through the lens of its post modern reception in Europe and America Profound connections between the verbal and the visual are illustrated by a rich trove of images including book illustrations stained glass postage stamps architecture and Christmas cards Presented with great clarity and simplicity Ziolkowski s work is accessible to the general reader while its many new discoveries will be valuable to academics in such fields and disciplines as medieval studies medievalism philology literary history art history folklore performance studies and reception studies

Thomas Cole's Journey

portrait prints ideally accompanied by Brief Lives sold by the thousands National histories were re issued to include pictures Portraitists were required to stage their sitters as though taken from real life situations Embedded into such interplay between texts and images was an aesthetic claim doing biography was a multimedia enterprise Far from being just words on a page eighteenth century life writing came with frontispiece portraits illustrations or elaborate title pages Biographers directed their readers to existing portraits of their subjects to enhance the reading experience Portraits made of calligraphic writing blurred the boundaries between text and image As a thorough reassessment of visual culture s role in producing biographies this book offers an in depth analysis of the rhetorics of portraiture and life writing an historical account of their sister arts tradition and an inquiry into the social function of profiling people

Modernism provides a new account of modernist literature's emergence in Britain. British writers played a central role in the dissemination of Russian literature and culture during the early twentieth century and their writing was transformed by the encounter. This study restores the thick history of that moment by analyzing networks of dissemination and reception to recover the role of neglected as well as canonical figures and institutions as well as individuals. The dominant account of British modernism privileges a Francophile genealogy but the turn of the century debate about the future of British writing was a triangular debate a debate not only between French and English models but between French, English and Russian models. Francophile modernists associated Russian literature especially the Tolstoyan novel with an uncritical immersion in life at the expense of a mastery of style and while individual works might be admired Russian literature as a whole was represented as a dangerous model for British writing. This supposed danger was closely bound up with the politics of the period and this book investigates how Russian culture was deployed in the close relationships between writers, editors and politicians who made up the early twentieth century intellectual class, the British intelligentsia. Russomania argues that the most significant impact of Russian culture is not to be found in stylistic borrowings between canonical authors but in the shaping of the major intellectual questions of the period: the relation between language and action, writer and audience and the work of art and lived experience. The resulting account brings an occluded genealogy of early modernism to the fore with a different arrangement of protagonists, different critical values and stronger lines of connection to the realist experiments of the Victorian past and the anti-formalism and revived romanticism of the 1930s and 1940s. *The Examiner*, 1846
