State and Agents in China Yongshun Cai, 2014-12-10 Chinese government officials have played a crucial role in China's economic development but they are also responsible for severe problems including environmental pollution violation of citizens rights failure in governance and corruption How does the Chinese Party state respond when a government official commits a duty related malfeasance or criminal activity And how does it balance the potential political costs of disciplining its own agents versus the loss of legitimacy in tolerating their misdeeds State and Agents in China explores how the party state addresses this dilemma uncovering the rationale behind the selective disciplining of government officials and its implications for governance in China By examining the discipline of state agents Cai shows how selective punishment becomes the means of balancing the need for and difficulties of disciplining agents and explains why some erring agents are tolerated while others are punished Cai finds that the effectiveness of punishing erring officials in China does not depend so much on the Party state's capacity to detect and punish each erring official but on the threat it creates when the Party state decides to mete out punishment Importantly the book also shows how relaxed discipline allows reform minded officials to use rule violating reform measures to address local problems and how such reform measures have significant implications for the regime's resilience

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Social Disciplining and Civilising Processes in China Thomas Heberer, 2023-08-11 This book argues that a major part of the Chinese government's road map formulated in 2017 to modernise China comprehensively by 2049 is the process of social disciplining It contends that the Chinese state sees that modernisation and modernity encompass not only economic and political administrative change but are also related to the organisation of society in general and the disciplining of this society and its individuals to create people with modernised

minds and behaviour and that moreover the Chinese state is aspiring to a modernity with Chinese characteristics The question of modernising by disciplining was extensively dealt with in the twentieth century by leading Western social scientists including Max Weber Norbert Elias and Michel Foucault who argued that disciplining extending from external coercion towards the internalisation of restraints is indispensable for achieving social order and thereby for civilisation but defined from a European perspective in relation to developments in Europe This book therefore not only discusses the Chinese experience of social disciplining but also by looking at a non Western society identifies universal tendencies of societal change and social disciplining and separates them from particular occurrences **China's Contained Resource**

Yongshun Cai, 2016-08-12 The Occupy movement in Hong Kong was sustained for about 80 days because of government tolerance the presence of determined participants and a weak leadership The government tolerated the occupation because its initial use of force in particular teargas was counterproductive and provoked large scale participation Unlike other social movements such as the 1989 Tiananmen movement the Occupy movement reached its peak of participation at the very beginning making it difficult to sustain the momentum The presence of determined participants who chose to stay until the government responded was crucial to the sustaining of the movement These self selected participants were caught in a dilemma between fruitless occupation and reluctance to retreat without a success The movement lasted also because the weak leadership was unable to force the government to concede or devise approaches for making a graceful exit Consequently site clearance became the common choice of both the government and the protestors This book develops a new framework to explain the sustaining of decentralized protest in the absence of strong movement organizations and leadership Sustained protests are worth research because they not only reveal the broad social context in which the protests arise and persist but also point out the dynamics of the escalation or the decline of the protests In addition sustained protest may not only lead to more dramatic action but they also result in the diffusion of protests or lead to significant policy changes Gao Village Revisited Mobo C F Gao, 2019-01-30 The personal stories of the Gao villagers demonstrate and are related to changes in China This is a close study of Gao Village twenty years after the author an anthropologist and native of Gao village wrote his original ethnography Gao Village It combines ethnographic analysis personal vignettes and a number of fascinating stories which presents a convincing yet complex picture of how Gao villagers interact with the outside world With his
