### VARYING SENTENCES

#### Vary Sentence Beginnings

- Begin with the middle of the sentence. For example, "The dragon soared over the mountains," can be changed to "Over the mountains, the dragon soared."
- Add a word or phrase to the beginning of the sentence. Think about how, when or where it took place: magnificently, on Saturday, in the castle.
- Think of a wonderful replacement for the overused first word. For example, replace the prince with monarch, future king, or his name.
- Combine related sentences.
- Try to make every sentence begin differently!

#### Vary Sentence Types

- Ask a question. Instead of saying, "The phoenix staggered," say "Did the phoenix actually stagger?"
- Use an exclamation to show excitement. For example, adding an exclamation mark to this sentence would show emotion: "He could hardly wait for his turn."
- Use an interjection. For example, add "Wow!" at a surprising part or "Oh no!" when something goes wrong.

### WORD CHOICE

#### Use Precise Words

- Select specific nouns. Instead of dinosaur, for example, you might say triceratops or brontosaurus.
- Choose words that fit the time and place. For example, people in the castle may wear pantaloons instead of pants.

#### Use Active Verbs

- Use active verbs instead of passive verbs (am, are, is, was, were, have, has, had). For example, instead of "the prince had a crown," say, "the wore a crown."
- Switch your sentence around. Instead of saying, "She had sparkling slippers on her feet," try "Sparkling slippers showed off her tiny feet."
- Replace verbs with more specific synonyms. For example, instead of "the troll walked," you might say, "the troll trudged" or "the troll marched."
- If you need some help, use a thesaurus.
