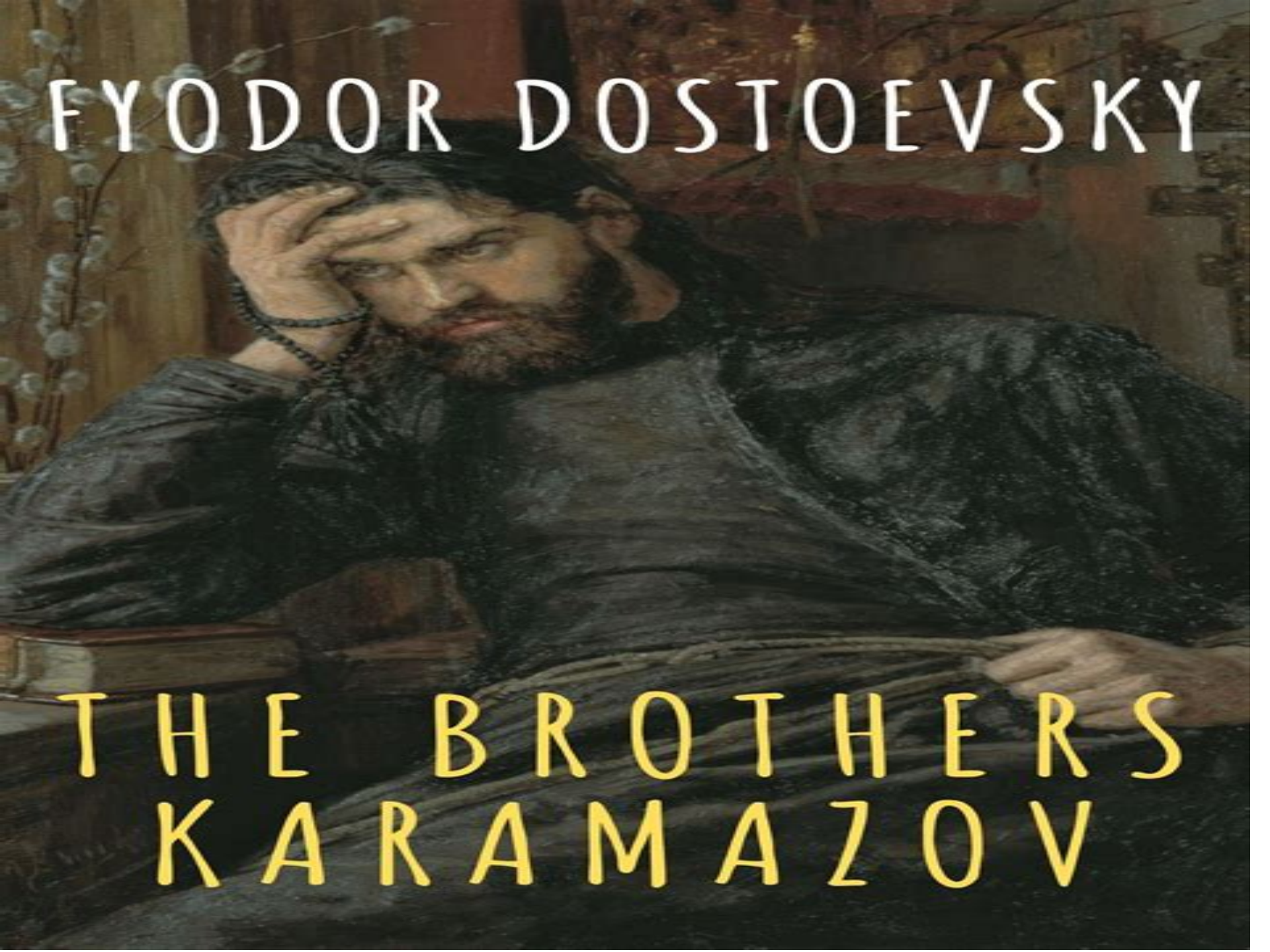

We are not born knowing our responsibilities as citizens and leaders; these matters have to be learned. *Sustaining a Free Society* moves to a consideration of the role schools must play in ensuring that future generations know and value a free society and are prepared to in turn assume their responsibilities.
