Webb, 2006-10-07 CLIFFORD K HO AND STEPHEN W WEBB Sandia National Laboratories P O Box 5800 Albuquerque NM 87185 USA Gas and vapor transport in porous media occur in a number of important applications including drying of industrial and food products oil and gas exploration environmental remediation of contaminated sites and carbon sequestration Understanding the fundamental mechanisms and processes of gas and vapor transport in porous media allows models to be used to evaluate and optimize the performance and design of these systems In this book gas and vapor are distinguished by their available states at standard temperature and pressure 20 C 101 kPa If the gas phase constituent can also exist as a liquid phase at standard temperature and pressure e g water ethanol toluene trichloroethylene it is considered a vapor If the gas phase constituent is non condensable at standard temperature and pressure e g oxygen carbon dioxide helium hydrogen propane it is considered a gas The distinction is important because different processes affect the transport and behavior of gases and vapors in porous media For example mechanisms specific to vapors include vapor pressure lowering and enhanced vapor diffusion which are caused by the presence of a liquid phase constituent interacting with its liquid phase in an unsaturated porous media In addition the heat pipe exploits isothermal latent heat exchange during evaporation and condensation to effectively transfer heat in designed and natural systems
