Vivre et survivre dans le Marais. , *Vivre et survivre dans le Marais* , **My Father and I** David Caron,2011-02-23 It is a living museum of a long gone Jewish life and supposedly a testimony to the success of the French model of social integration It is a communal home where gay men and women are said to stand in defiance of the French model of social integration It is a place of freedom and tolerance where people of color and lesbians nevertheless feel unwanted and where young Zionists from the suburbs gather every Sunday and sometimes harass Arabs It is a hot topic in the press and on television It is open to the world and open for business It is a place to be seen and a place of invisibility It is like a home to me a place where I feel both safe and out of place and where my father felt comfortable and alienated at the same time It is a place of nostalgia innovation shame pride and anxiety where the local and the global intersect for better and for worse And for better and for worse it is a French neighborhood from My Father and I Mixing personal memoir urban studies cultural history and literary criticism as well as a generous selection of photographs My Father and I focuses on the Marais the oldest surviving neighborhood of Paris It also beautifully reveals the intricacies of the relationship between a Jewish father and a gay son each claiming the same neighborhood as his own Beginning with the history of the Marais and its significance in the construction of a French national identity David Caron proposes a rethinking of community and looks at how Jews Chinese immigrants and gays have made the Marais theirs These communities embody in their engagement of urban space a daily challenge to the French concept of universal citizenship that denies them all political legitimacy Caron moves from the strictly French context to more theoretical issues such as social and political archaism immigration and diaspora survival and haunting the public private divide and group friendship as metaphor for unruly and dynamic forms of community and founding disasters such as AIDS and the Holocaust Caron also tells the story of his father a Hungarian Jew and Holocaust survivor who immigrated to France and once called the Marais home **Vivre et survivre dans le Marais** ,2005 *The Russian Jewish Diaspora and European Culture, 1917-1937* Jörg Schulte,Olga Tabachnikova,Peter Wagstaff,2012-04-03 The Jewish emigration from Russia after the Revolution of 1917 changed the face of Jewish culture in Western Europe Russian Jews brought with them the visions of a national Jewish literature in Hebrew Yiddish or Russian and new concepts of secular Jewish music and art Often they acted as intermediaries between Jewish centres in Europe which resulted in the creation of a single sphere of Jewish culture common to all parts of the European diaspora Although some stayed in Western Europe for only a few years before moving on to Palestine the budding Hebrew culture in Palestine would not have been the same without this relatively short period of intense contact between Russian Jewish and Western European cultures *Medical Imperialism in French North Africa* Richard C. Parks,2017-10 French colonial Tunisia in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries witnessed shifting concepts of identity including varying theories of ethnic essentialism a drive toward modernization and imperialist interpretations of science and medicine As French colonizers worked to realize ideas of a

modern city and empire they undertook a program to significantly alter the physical and social realities by which the people of Tunisia lived often in ways that continue to influence life today Medical Imperialism in French North Africa demonstrates the ways in which diverse members of the Jewish community of Tunis received rejected or reworked myriad imperial projects devised to foster the social corporeal and moral regeneration of their community Buttressed by the authority of science and medicine regenerationist schemes such as urban renewal projects and public health reforms were deployed to destroy and recast the cultural social and political lives of Jewish colonial subjects Richard C Parks expands on earlier scholarship to examine how notions of race class modernity and otherness shaped these efforts Looking at such issues as the plasticity of identity the collaboration and contention between French and Tunisian Jewish communities Jewish women s negotiation of social power relationships in Tunis and the razing of the city s Jewish quarter Parks fills the gap in current literature by focusing on the broader transnational context of French actions in colonial Tunisia

Instrument of Memory Lisa Lampert-Weissig, 2024-01-18 How can immortality be a curse According to the Wandering Jew legend as Jesus made his way to Calvary a man refused him rest cruelly taunting him to hurry to meet his fate In response Jesus cursed the man to wander until the Second Coming Since the medieval period the legend has inspired hundreds of adaptations by artists and writers Instrument of Memory Encounters with the Wandering Jew the first English language study of the legend in over fifty years is also the first to examine the influence of the legend s medieval and early modern sources over the centuries into the present day Using the lens of memory studies the work shows how the Christian tradition of the legend centered the memory of the Passion at the heart of the Wandering Jew s curse Instrument of Memory also shows how Jewish artists and writers have reimagined the legend through Jewish memory traditions Through this focus on memory Jewish adapters of the legend create complex renderings of the Wandering Jew that recognize not only the entanglement of Jewish and Christian memory but also the impact of that entanglement on Jewish subjects This book presents a complex sympathetic and more fully realized version of the legend while challenging the limits of the presentism of memory studies

Histoire des Filles de la Charité (XVIIe-XVIIIe siècles) Matthieu Brejon de Lavergnée, 2011-04-13 Les Filles de la Charité sont aujourd hui encore la principale congrégation féminine hospitalière et enseignante avec 20 000 sœurs dans près de 100 pays Des clairs obscurs de la photographie des années 1950 aux jubilatoires cornettes au vent des 2 CV de Louis de Funès de la pittoresque chatoyante des deux millions de fidèles qui défilent chaque année dans la chapelle de la miraculeuse de la rue du Bac aux iconoclastes défilés de mode qui réinventent leur coiffe qui ne connaissent pas les claires sœurs de Saint Vincent de Paul L ouverture des archives privées de la Compagnie croisée avec les archives publiques notamment les papiers saisis en 1792 et conservés par les Archives nationales a enfin permis d écrire leur histoire Fruit d un travail de quatre années ce volume court de la fondation par Vincent de Paul et Louise de Marillac d une confrérie de bonnes filles au service des pauvres nourrie par la spiritualité de l imitation de Jésus Christ propre à l école française la suppression des sœurs grises par la Révolution Au croisement de l histoire

des femmes et de l'histoire religieuse cette tude s'inscrit dans le courant des gender studies particulièrement d'veloppées dans l'historiographie anglo-saxonne, allemande ou encore italienne. Cet essai d'histoire totale d'une congrégation religieuse claire ainsi l'histoire de l'ancienne France de ses splendeurs aussi bien que de ses misères. *PARIS, 1199* Jean d'Aillon, 1199. Tandis qu'il assiège le château de Chalus pour punir son vassal qui refuse de lui remettre un trésor d'or couvert par un laboureur Richard Cœur de Lion, roi d'Angleterre et duc d'Aquitaine, est atteint d'un carreau d'arbalète. Bien que la blessure soit bénigne, Richard traverse quelques jours plus tard entouré de sa mère Aliénor et de son ami Robert de Locksley, un ancien hors-la-loi connu dans sa jeunesse sous le nom de Robin Hood. Mais le roi d'Angleterre mort, le trésor disparaît et Locksley, accusé du vol, prend la fuite. Pour le retrouver, sa jeune épouse Anna Maria demande l'aide de Guilhem d'Ussel, ancien mercenaire et homme lige de Raymond de Saint-Gilles, comte de Toulouse. En recherchant Locksley, Paris, autour du manoir du vieux Temple et dans le quartier Saint-Gervais, surtout habité par des tisserands, Guilhem découvre que la mort de Richard est le début d'un vaste complot visant l'assassinat de Philippe Auguste. Pourchassé par les templiers, recherché par la justice de l'évêché et traqué par le prévôt de Paris, Guilhem d'Ussel retrouvera-t-il Locksley vivant ? Peut-il faire confiance à ces tisserands hérétiques qui se nomment cathares et se réunissent la nuit dans les sous-sols de la tour du Petit au Diable pour prier ? Parviendra-t-il à sauver la femme qu'il aime du bûcher ? Qui est cet archer infailible, seul capable de tuer le roi de France ? Cette version de l'ouvrage publiée aux Éditions J'ai lu a entièrement révisée le 2013. Elle est complétée par un lexique et une courte nouvelle, Les perdrix de Lectoure. Au début du Carême de l'année 1199, Guilhem d'Ussel se rend à Lectoure pour rencontrer le comte d'Armagnac, son futur suzerain. Mais dans l'hôtellerie où il passe la nuit, la femme de l'aubergiste fait trop cuire des perdrix sur leur broche. Cet incident provoquera un abominable drame et si Guilhem parviendra à maîtriser le cheveu des morts violentes, il manquera de peu d'y perdre aussi la vie.

Mardochée Naggjar Lucette Valensi, 2008-03-26. Qui est Mardochée Naggjar ? Un inconnu dont les traces sont ténues mais d'emblée intrigantes. Dans son journal, un missionnaire anglais ayant séjourné à Tunis en 1821, parle de ce Juif cultivé, auteur d'une grammaire et d'un lexique berbères qui lui apprenait l'arabe, devisait librement sur la condition de ses coreligionnaires et avait de l'entree tant à Paris chez quelques savants qu'à Tunis au palais beylical. C'est bien assez pour lancer Lucette Valensi sur sa piste. L'homme a voyagé, fait des rencontres tissées des liens avec divers orientalistes européens. L'historienne mène l'enquête, convoque les témoins et cerne progressivement son personnage à travers les images fracturées par ceux qui furent ses interlocuteurs ou ses contemporains. On découvre ainsi Naggjar à Paris, sous le Consulat et les premières années de l'Empire, installé du côté de la place des Victoires, il fréquente la Bibliothèque nationale, croise Silvestre de Sacy et d'autres lettrés pour lesquels il effectue des travaux de traduction. On le suit à Trieste, il commerce, copie, traduit, fournit des manuscrits, ses correspondants rudimentaires tandis que le tumulte de la guerre secoue l'Europe. On le retrouve à Tunis, dans le sillage du comte Camille Borgia, friand de textes historiques, au Bardo, le palais du Bey où il est interprète officiel dans le quartier franc où il rencontre des consuls européens au port de la Goulette où il va récupérer des chargements de

mouchoirs fins ou ces cygnes cureuils et chats angoras r clam s faute d esp ces sonnantes un orientaliste hollandais qui a omis de le payer Sans doute habite t il le quartier juif o il s est remari avec une jeune vierge Lucette Valensi ajustant avec précision et talent les fragments de vie parvient retrouver Mardoch e Naggiar en son temps Elle fait ainsi exister la crois e de plusieurs mondes cet individu singulier qui n tait pas vou la post rit *Vel d'hiv - 16 juillet 1942* Alain Vincenot,2012-05-16 Il y a 70 ans les 16 et 17 juillet 1942 dans la capitale occup e la police parisienne se livrait sur ordre des nazis la plus grande rafle jamais organis e en France plus de 12 000 Juifs dont 4 000 enfants taient arr t s dans le cadre de l op ration Vent printanier Les c libataires et les familles sans enfants de moins de seize ans taient aussit t dirig s vers le camp de Drancy les autres taient parqu s au V lodrome d Hiver Les conditions d internement taient effroyables La soif la faim l absence d hygi ne La plupart de ces malheureux mourront Auschwitz Le 16 juillet 1995 dans un discours historique reproduit dans le livre Jacques Chirac dira La France ce jour l accomplissait l irr parable Ce livre inclut les t moignages in dits de survivants de la rafle la plupart taient enfants l poque ainsi que des photographies d eux et de leurs familles d truites Il pr sente galement une chronologie d taill e des mesures antis mites prises par Hitler partir de 1933 et par le gouvernement de Vichy partir de 1940
